What you will need:

RED HEART® Boutique Treasure™:
4 balls 1913 Spectrum
Note: One ball needed for hat and three for the cowl.

Susan Bates® Knitting Needles:
8.0mm [US 11]
Susan Bates® Circular Knitting Needles: 5.0mm [US 8] and 5.5mm [US 9], 16" [41 cm] long
Susan Bates® Double Pointed Knitting Needles: 5.5 mm [US 9]

Stitch marker, cable needle, yarn needle

GAUGES:

Cowl: 15 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 20 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Stockinette st using 8.0mm [US 11] needles. **Hat:** 16 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 22 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Stockinette st using 5.5mm [US 9] needles. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size needle to obtain the gauge.

SHOP KIT



Slouchy Hat & Reversible Cable Cowl

This is the perfect hat and cowl set knit with beautifully shaded yarn. The hat is roomy, and since the cowl is reversible you don't have to be sure just one side is showing.

Cowl measures : 10" wide x 46" diameter [25 cm x 117 cm]

Hat measures: 14" (unstretched), 21" (stretched) [36-53 cm] in circumference

SPECIAL STITCHES

2/2 LC: 2 over 2 Left Cross = Slip next 2 sts to cable needle and hold to front, k2, then k2 from cable needle.

K2TOG = Knit 2 sts together.

TBL = Through the back loop.

WYIF = With yarn holding in front of work.

NOTE

Cowl is reversible, cable rows are worked on both sides of piece.

COWL

Using 8.0mm [US 11] needles, cast on 56 sts.
Row 1: K1 tbl, p1, *k1, p1* 2 times, *k4, p4* 5 times, k4, *p1, k1* 2 times, p1, wyif, slip last st purlwise.

Row 2: K1 tbl, k1, *p1, k1* 2 times, *p4, k4* 5 times, p4, *k1, p1* 2 times, k1, wyif, slip last st purlwise.

Rows 3-4: Repeat Rows 1-2.

Row 5: K1 tbl, p1, *k1, p1* 2 times, *2/2 LC, p4* 5 times, 2/2 LC, *p1, k1* 2 times, p1, wyif, slip last st purlwise.

Row 6: Repeat Row 2.

Rows 7-10: Repeat Rows 1-2.

Row 11: Repeat Row 1.

Row 12: K1 tbl, k1, *p1, k1* 2 times, *p4, 2/2 LC* 5 times, p4, *k1, p1* 2 times, k1, wyif slip last st purlwise.

Repeat Rows 1-12 until piece measures 46" [117 cm] from cast on edge.

Bind off all sts as they appear.

FINISHING

Fold piece in half matching short ends. Twist one side twice and sew edge seam. Weave in ends. Lightly block to shape.

HAT

Using 5.0mm [US 8] circular needles, cast on 80 sts. Join, being careful not to twist sts and place st marker to mark beginning of round.

Round 1: K2, p1 around.

Repeat Round 1 until ribbing measures 1.5" [4 cm] from cast on edge, increasing 12 sts evenly spaced on last Round 92 sts. Change to 5.5mm [US 9] circular needles.

Rounds 1-4: Purl all sts.

Rounds 5-8: Knit all sts.

Rounds 9-40: Repeat Rounds 1-8.

Rounds 41-48: Repeat Rounds 1-8, decreasing 12 sts evenly spaced on last Round 80 sts.

Shape Crown

Change to double pointed needles when there are too few sts to use the circular needles.

Rounds 1-4: Purl all sts.

Round 5: *K8, k2tog* around 72 sts.

Rounds 6-7: Knit all sts.

Round 8: K7, k2tog* around 64 sts.

Rounds 9-12: Purl all sts.

Round 13: *K6, k2tog* around 56 sts.

Rounds 14-15: Knit all sts.

Round 16: *K5, k2tog* around 48 sts.

Rounds 17-20: Purl all sts..

Round 21: *K4, k2tog* around 40 sts.

Round 22: Knit all sts.

Round 23: *K3, k2tog* around 32 sts.

Round 24: Knit all sts.

Round 25: *K2, k2tog* around 24 sts.

Round 26: Knit all sts..

Round 27: *K2tog* around 12 sts.

FINISHING

Cut yarn leaving an 8" [20 cm] length for sewing.

Thread yarn needle with end and slip remaining sts onto yarn needle; pull tightly to close and secure ends.

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit; **K2tog** = knit 2 sts together; **mm** = millimeters; **P** = purl; (sts); **st(s)** = stitch(es); **Tbl** = through the back loop; **Wyif** = with yarn holding in front of work; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
