What you will need:

RED HEART® Scrubby Sparkle™: 1 ball each 8506 Icepop **A**, 8001 Marshmallow **B**, 8260 Orange **C**, and 8012 Licorice **D**

Note: Only small quantities of **C** and **D** are needed for this project.

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 5mm [US H-8]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: Gauge is not critical for this project.



RED HEART® Scrubby Sparkle™, Art. E851 available in 3 oz (85 g), 174 yd (159 m) balls

Snowman in the Square Scrubby

Using Scrubby Sparkle gives this handy fella a festive vibe and makes washing party dishes a jolly time. He's perfect to give as a gift with some nice lotion or soap.

Scrubby measures 6" x 6" (15 x 15 cm), excluding bow.

Special Stitches

Bpdc (back post double crochet) =

Yarn over, insert hook from back side of work to front and to back again around the post of indicated stitch; yarn over and pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 2 loops (2 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 2 loops (1 loop on hook). Skip the stitch "in front of" the Bpdc.

Fpdc (front post double crochet) =

Yarn over, insert hook from front side of work to back and to front again around post of indicated stitch; yarn over and pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 2 loops (2 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 2 loops (1 loop on hook).

SCRUBBY

With **A**, ch 25.

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook (beginning skipped ch count as first dc) and in each ch across, turn—23 dc.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout) *fpdc around next dc, bpdcc around next dc; repeat from * across to last 2 dc, fpdc around next dc, dc in top of beginning ch, turn.

Row 3: Ch 3, *bpdcc around next dc, fpdc around next dc; repeat from * across to last 2 dc, bpdcc around next dc, dc in top of beginning ch; change to **B**, turn.

Rows 4–13: Repeat Rows 2 and 3 five times.

Fasten off.

Carrot Nose

With **C**, ch 10.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 2 ch, hdc in next 3 ch, dc in last 3 ch, turn—9 sts.

Row 2: Ch 3, dc in next 2 dc, hdc in next 3 hdc, sc in next 2 sc, sl st in last sc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Eye (make 2)

With **D**, ch 2.

Round 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Bow

With **A**, ch 22.

Rows 1 and 2: Repeat Rows 1 and 2 of snowman. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

FINISHING

Refer to photograph as a guide to placement of all pieces.

Sew eyes in place. With **D**, embroider mouth with back stitches. Trim "lashes" of eyes and mouth to emphasize. Tie a loose knot in bow and sew to side of snowman.

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C, etc.; **ch** = chain(s); **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.

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
