**SIZES**

**To fit bust measurement**

<b>Extra-Small/Small</b>	<b>28-34" [71-86.5 cm]</b>
<b>Medium</b>	<b>36-38" [91.5-96.5 cm]</b>
<b>Large</b>	<b>40-42" [101.5-106.5 cm]</b>
<b>Extra-Large</b>	<b>44-46" [112-117 cm]</b>
<b>2/3 X-Large</b>	<b>48-54" [122-137 cm]</b>
<b>4/5 X-Large</b>	<b>56-62" [142-157.5 cm]</b>

**Finished bust**

<b>Extra-Small/Small</b>	<b>36" [91.5 cm]</b>
<b>Medium</b>	<b>40" [101.5 cm]</b>
<b>Large</b>	<b>44" [112 cm]</b>
<b>Extra-Large</b>	<b>48" [122 cm]</b>
<b>2/3 X-Large</b>	<b>56" [142 cm]</b>
<b>4/5 X-Large</b>	<b>64" [162.5 cm]</b>

**MATERIALS**

**Patons® Grace™** (50 g/1.75 oz; 125 m/136 yds)  
**Sizes XS/S M L XL 2/3XL 4/5XL**  
 Sunkissed (62622) **5 6 6 7 8 10 balls**

Sizes 3.5 mm (U.S. 4) and 3.75 mm (U.S. 5) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain tension.** 2 stitch holders.

**TENSION**

24 sts and 32 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st with larger needles.

**STITCH GLOSSARY**

<b>Alt</b> = Alternate(ing)	<b>Pssso</b> = Pass slipped stitch over
<b>Approx</b> = Approximate(ly)	<b>Rep</b> = Repeat
<b>Beg</b> = Begin(ing)	<b>RS</b> = Right side
<b>Cont</b> = Continue(ity)	<b>Sl1</b> = Slip next stitch knitwise
<b>Dec</b> = Decrease(ing)	<b>Ssk</b> = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together.
<b>K</b> = Knit	<b>St(s)</b> = Stitch(es)
<b>K2tog</b> = Knit next 2 stitches together	<b>WS</b> = Wrong side
<b>P2tog</b> = Purl next 2 stitches together	<b>Yo</b> = Yarn over
<b>P2togtbl</b> = Purl next 2 stitches together through back loops	
<b>Pat</b> = Pattern	

**INSTRUCTIONS**

*The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus ( ). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.*

**Lace Panel Pat I** (worked over 15 sts). (See chart on page 2).

- 1st row:** K4. K2tog. (K1. yo) twice. K1. ssk. K4.
- 2nd and alt rows:** Purl.
- 3rd row:** K3. K2tog. K1. yo. K3. yo. K1. ssk. K3.
- 5th row:** K2. K2tog. K1. yo. K5. yo. K1. ssk. K2.
- 7th row:** K1. K2tog. K1. yo. K7. yo. K1. ssk. K1.
- 8th row:** Purl.

These 8 rows form Lace Panel Pat I.

**Lace Panel Pat II** (worked over 15 sts).

- 1st row:** K1. K2tog. K1. yo. K2. K2tog. yo. K3. yo. K1. ssk. K1.
  - 2nd and alt rows:** Purl.
  - 3rd row:** K4. K2tog. (K1. yo) twice. K1. ssk. K4.
  - 5th row:** K3. K2tog. K1. yo. K3. yo. K1. ssk. K3.
  - 7th row:** K2. K2tog. K1. yo. K5. yo. K1. ssk. K2.
  - 9th row:** K1. K2tog. K1. yo. K2. K2tog. yo. K3. yo. K1. ssk. K1.
  - 11th row:** K3. yo. ssk. K1. yo. Sl1. K2tog. pssso. yo. K1. K2tog. yo. K3.
  - 13th row:** K4. yo. ssk. K2tog. yo. K1. K2tog. yo. K4.
  - 15th row:** K5. yo. ssk. K1. K2tog. yo. K5.
  - 17th row:** K6. yo. Sl1. K2tog. pssso. yo. K6.
  - 18th row:** Purl.
- These 18 rows form Lace Panel Pat II.

**BACK**

\*\*With smaller needles, cast on **108 (124-132-143-169-192)** sts.

Knit 5 rows (garter st), noting first row is WS.

Change to larger needles and proceed in pat as follows:

**1st row:** (RS). **K9 (2-6-4-2-6)**. Work 1st row of Lace Panel Pat I **6 (8-8-9-11-12)** times. **K9 (2-6-4-2-6)**.

**2nd row:** **P9 (2-6-4-2-6)**. Work 2nd row of Lace Panel Pat I **6 (8-8-9-11-12)** times. **P9 (2-6-4-2-6)**. Lace Panel Pat I is now in position.

Cont as established until work from beg measures approx **7 (7-8-8-9-9)" [18 (18-20.5-20.5-23-23) cm]**, ending on a 6th row of Lace Panel Pat I.

**Next row:** (RS). **K9 (2-6-4-2-6)**. Work 1st row of Lace Panel Pat II **6 (8-8-9-11-12)** times. **K9 (2-6-4-2-6)**.

**2nd row:** **P9 (2-6-4-2-6)**. Work 2nd row of Lace Panel Pat II **6 (8-8-9-11-12)** times. **P9 (2-6-4-2-6)**. Lace Panel Pat II is now in position.

Cont even until 18th row of Lace Panel Pat II is complete.

Cont even in stocking st until work piece from beg measures **14 (14-14-15-15-15)" [35.5 (35.5-35.5-38-38-38) cm]**, ending on a purl row.

**Shape armholes:** Cast off **5 (6-6-7-8-9)** sts beg of next **2 (2-2-2-4-4)** rows. **98 (112-120-129-137-156)** sts.\*\*

**Sizes XL, 2/3XL and 4/5XL only:** **1st row:** K1. K2tog. Knit to last 3 sts. ssk. K1.

**2nd row:** P1. P2togtbl. Purl to last 3 sts. P2tog. P1.

Rep last 2 rows **(1-2-8)** time(s) more. **(121-125-120)** sts.

**All sizes:** **1st row:** K1. K2tog. Knit to last 3 sts. ssk. K1.

**2nd row:** Purl.

Rep last 2 rows **3 (6-9-8-8-5)** times more. **90 (98-100-103-107-108)** sts.

Cont even until armhole measures **6 (6½-6½-7-7-7½)" [15 (16.5-16.5-18-18-19) cm]**, ending with a purl row.

**Shape neck: Next row:** **K21 (24-24-25-26-26)** (neck edge). **Turn.** Leave rem sts on a st holder. Dec 1 st at neck edge on next 6 rows. **15 (18-18-19-20-20)** sts.

Cont even until armhole measures **7½ (8-8-8½-8½-9)" [19 (20.5-20.5-21.5-21.5-23) cm]**, ending with a purl row.

**Shape shoulder:** Cast off **7 (9-9-9-10-10)** sts beg of next row. Purl 1 row. Cast off rem **8 (9-9-10-10-10)** sts.
