

SUGAR BUSH SAVVY CROCHET SNOODLE | CROCHET



MATERIALS

Sugar Bush® Canoe™ (1.75 oz/50 g; 95 yds/87 m)
Sunset (7008) **5 balls**

Size U.S. L/11 (8 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
5 buttons. Tapestry needle.

 CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

Ch = Chain(s)

Dc = Double crochet

Pat = Pattern

Rep = Repeat

Sc = Single crochet

Sl st = Slip stitch

Sp = Space

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

Yoh = Yarn over hook

MEASUREMENTS

Buttoned up: 14" [35.5 cm] wide x
19" [48.5 cm] long.

Unbuttoned: 30" [76 cm] wide
(including buttonhole edging).

GAUGE

2 pattern repeats and 6 rows = 5"
[12.5 cm]

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Ch 3 at beg of row counts as dc.

Ch 74.

1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook.
1 sc in each ch to end of chain.
Turn. 73 sc.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. *Skip
next 2 sts. 7 dc in next st - shell
made. Skip next 2 sts. 1 sc in next
st. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 3. (Yoh and draw up
a loop in next st. Yoh and draw
through 2 loops on hook) 3 times.
Yoh and draw through 4 loops on
hook - 3 dc cluster made. Ch 3.
1 sc in next dc. Ch 3. *(Yoh and draw
up a loop in next st. Yoh and draw
through 2 loops on hook) 7 times.
Yoh and draw through 8 loops on
hook - 7 dc cluster made. Ch 3.
1 sc in next dc. Ch 3. Rep from * to
last 4 sts. (Yoh and draw up a loop
in next st. Yoh and draw through
2 loops on hook) 4 times. Yoh and
draw through 5 loops on hook -
4 dc cluster made. Turn.

4th row: 3 dc in first st. Skip next
ch-3 sp. 1 sc in next sc. *Skip next
ch-3 sp. 7 dc in next st. Skip next
ch-3 sp. 1 sc in next sc. Rep from *
to last ch-3 sp. Skip last ch-3 sp. 4
dc in last st. Turn.

5th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first dc. *Ch 3. 7 dc cluster. Ch 3. 1 sc in next dc. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

6th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. *Skip next ch-3 sp. 7 dc in next st. Skip next ch-3 sp. 1 sc in next sc.

7th to 31st rows: Rep 3rd to 6th rows 6 times more, then 3rd row once more.

Do not fasten off. Proceed as follows:

Buttonhole edging: Lie Snoodle flat. Mark sp between 3rd and 6th rows for buttonhole. Ch 3 and turn to work down side of Snoodle. 2 dc in ch-3 sp (makes half shell). *Skip ch 3 from beg of previous row. 1 sc in next sp. 7 dc in sp between 3rd and 6th rows (buttonhole shell made). Rep from * across, ending with 1 sc in last sp. Sl st to beg of foundation row (top edge). Fasten off. (7 full shells and half shell = 8 buttonholes).

Button edging: 1st row: (WS).

Join yarn with sl st in first st of 31st row and work 1 row of sc evenly along side edge of Snoodle, adding 2 sc each dc row and 1 sc in final sc row. Turn. 61 sts.

2nd to 4th rows: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Fasten off.

Attach buttons evenly up edge of Snoodle to correspond with buttonholes. Weave in ends.
