Gray Heather (H9509)

Sizes U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) and U.S. 8 (5 mm) Susan Bates® knitting needles

or size needed to obtain gauge. Susan Bates®

Stitch markers. 4 stitch holders. Susan Bates® Yarn needle.

## GAUGE

18 sts and 32 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Mosaic Pat with larger needles.

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (.). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

## Notes:

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull tie to remove.
- Easily separate colors of each O'go by gently pulling apart and cutting at the color transition.
- Follow color guide shown in Materials section for each O'Go Contrast A and B.

## FRONT AND BACK (make alike)

\*\*With smaller needles and A, cast on **79 (87-94-110-125-133)** sts. Knit 3 rows, noting 1st row is WS. **Next 2 rows:** With B, knit. **Next 4 rows:** With A, knit. Rep last 6 rows 4 times more, inc **3 (3-4-4-5-5)** sts evenly across last row. **82 (90-98-114-130-138)** sts. PM at each end of last row.

Change to larger needles and proceed as follows:

**1st row:** (RS). With B, knit.  
**2nd row:** P1. P1, wrapping yarn twice around needle. \*P4. (P1, wrapping yarn twice around needle) 4 times. Rep from \* to last 8 sts. P4. (P1, wrapping yarn twice around needle) 3 times. P1.

**3rd row:** With A, K1. Sl3Pwyib, dropping extra loops. \*K4. Sl4Pwyib, dropping extra loops. Rep from \* to last 6 sts. K4. Sl1Pwyib. K1.

**4th row:** K1. Sl1Pwyif. \*K4. Sl4Pwyif. Rep from \* to last 8 sts. K4. Sl3Pwyif. K1.

**5th row:** With B, knit.

**6th row:** P2. \*(P1, wrapping yarn twice around needle) 4 times. P4. Rep from \* to end of row.

**7th row:** With A, \*K4. Sl4Pwyib, dropping extra loops. Rep from \* to last 6 sts. Sl4Pwyib, dropping extra loops. K2.

**8th row:** K2. \*Sl4Pwyif. K4. Rep from \* to end of row.

**9th to 32nd rows:** Rep last 8 rows 3 times more.

**33rd row:** (RS). With A, knit.

**34th row:** P1. P1, wrapping yarn twice around needle. \*P4. (P1, wrapping yarn twice around needle) 4 times. Rep from \* to last 8 sts. P4. (P1, wrapping yarn twice around needle) 3 times. P1.

**35th row:** With B, K1. Sl3Pwyib, dropping extra loops. \*K4. Sl4Pwyib, dropping extra loops. Rep from \* to last 6 sts. K4. Sl1Pwyib. K1.

**36th row:** K1. Sl1Pwyif. \*K4. Sl4Pwyif. Rep from \* to last 8 sts. K4. Sl3Pwyif. K1.

**37th row:** With A, knit.

**38th row:** P2. \*(P1, wrapping yarn twice around needle) 4 times. P4. Rep from \* to end of row.

**39th row:** With B, \*K4. Sl4Pwyib, dropping extra loops. Rep from \* to last 6 sts. Sl4Pwyib, dropping extra loops. K2.

**40th row:** K2. \*Sl4Pwyif. K4. Rep from \* to end of row.

**41st to 64th rows:** Rep last 8 rows 3 times more.

These 64 rows form Mosaic Pat.

Cont in pat until work from beg measures 18" [45.5 cm], ending on a WS row.

**Shape raglans:** Keeping cont of pat, cast off **3 (4-5-7-9-10)** sts beg next 2 rows. **76 (82-88-100-112-118)** sts.

**1st row:** (RS). K2. ssk. Pat to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.

**2nd row:** P2. Pat to last 2 sts. P2.

**3rd row:** K2. Pat to last 2 sts. K2.

**4th row:** As 2nd row.

Rep last 4 rows **15 (14-11-7-4-2)** times more. **44 (52-64-84-102-112)** sts.

**Next row:** (RS). K2. ssk. Pat to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.

**Next row:** P2. Pat to last 2 sts. P2. Rep last 2 rows **0 (4-10-20-28-32)** times more.

Leave rem **42 (42-42-42-44-46)** sts on a st holder.\*\*

## SLEEVES

With smaller needles and A, cast on **45 (45-47-47-51-51)** sts.

Knit 3 rows, noting 1st row is WS.

**Next 2 rows:** With B, knit.

**Next 4 rows:** With A, knit.

Rep last 6 rows twice more, inc 3 sts evenly across last row. **45 (45-47-47-51-51)** sts.

Change to larger needles and proceed in Mosaic Pat as given for Front, inc 1 st each end of every following **6th (6th-4th-4th-8th-8th)** row until there are **49 (57-61-73-55-65)** sts, then every following **8th (8th-6th-6th-4th-4th)** row until there are **63 (65-73-77-83-85)** sts, taking inc sts into Mosaic Pat.

Cont even in pat until work from beg measures approx 17" [43 cm], ending on same row of pat as Front before beg of raglan shaping.

**Shape raglans:** Keeping cont of pat, cast off **3 (4-5-7-9-10)** sts beg next 2 rows. **57 (57-63-63-65-65)** sts.

**1st row:** (RS). K2. ssk. Pat to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.

**2nd row:** P2. Pat to last 2 sts. P2.

**3rd row:** K2. Pat to last 2 sts. K2.

**4th row:** As 2nd row.

Rep last 4 rows **8 (10-8-10-11-11)** times more. **39 (35-45-41-41-41)** sts.

**Next row:** K2. ssk. Pat to last 4 sts. K2tog. K2.

**Next row:** P2. Pat to last 2 sts. P2. Rep last 2 rows until **9 (9-11-11-11-11)** sts rem. Leave rem sts on a st holder.

## FINISHING

Pin garment pieces to measurements. Cover with damp cloth, leaving cloth to dry.

Sew raglan seams leaving back left raglan open.

**Note:** Secure seam sts so they will not unravel.

## COLLAR

**Sizes XS/S, M, L and XL only:**

**1st row:** (RS). With smaller needles and A, K**9 (9-11-11)** from left sleeve st holder. PM. K**42** from front st holder. PM. K**9 (9-11-11)** from right sleeve st holder. PM. K**42** from back st holder. PM. **102 (102-106-106)** sts.

**Size 2/3XL only:** **1st row:** (RS). With smaller needles and A, K1. K2tog. K5. K2tog. K1 from left sleeve st holder. PM. K**44** from front st holder. PM. K1. K2tog. K5. K2tog. K1 from right sleeve st holder. PM. K**44** from back st holder. PM. 106 sts.

**Size 4/5XL only:** **1st row:** (RS). With smaller needles and A, K1. K2tog. K5. K2tog. K1 from left sleeve st holder. PM. K2tog. K**42** from front st holder. K2tog. PM. K1. K2tog. K5. K2tog. K1 from right sleeve st holder. PM. K2tog. K**42** from back st holder. K2tog. PM. 106 sts.

**All sizes: 2nd and alt rows:** Knit.

**3rd row:** With A, knit.

**5th row:** With B, \*Knit to marker. SM. K2tog. Knit to 2 sts before marker. K2tog. SM. Rep from \* once more. **98 (98-102-102-102-102)** sts.

**7th row:** With A, knit.

**9th rows:** With A, as 5th row. **94 (94-98-98-98-98)** sts.

**11th row:** With B, knit.

**13th row:** With A, as 5th row. **90 (90-94-94-94-94)** sts.

Rep 2nd to 13th rows once more, then 2nd and 3rd rows once. **78 (78-82-82-82-82)** sts after 13th row.

Cast off knitwise (WS).

Sew raglan and Collar seam using flat seam.

Sew sleeve and side seams to markers, leaving open after markers for side slits.
