GAUGE

15 sts and 20 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking stitch.

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger size(s) the instructions will be written thus (.). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

BACK

Cast on **83 (91-99-109-117-129)** sts.

1st row: (RS). *K1. P1. Rep from * to last st. K1.

2nd row: *P1. K1. Rep from * to last st. P1.

3rd and 4th rows: Knit.

Rep last 4 rows twice more (12 rows in total have been worked).

Proceed in pat as follows:

1st row: (RS). *P1. K1. Rep from * to last st. P1.

2nd row: *K1. P1. Rep from * to last st. K1.

3rd row: *K1. P1. Rep from * to last st. K1.

4th row: *P1. K1. Rep from * to last st. P1.

These 4 rows form Irish Moss St Pat.

Cont in Irish Moss St Pat, dec 1 st each end of next row and following 12th rows until there are **75 (83-91-101-109-121)** sts.

Cont even in pat until work from beg measures 19" [48 cm], ending on a WS row.

Shape armholes: Keeping cont of pat, cast off **5 (7-9-12-14-18)** sts at beg of next 2 rows. **65 (69-73-77-81-85)** sts.

Cont even in pat until armholes measure **9 (9½-10-10-10½-10½)" [23 (24.5-25.5-25.5-26.5-26.5) cm]**, ending on a WS row. Cast off. Place markers **18 (20-21-23-24-26)** sts in from each side edge for shoulders.

LEFT FRONT

Cast on **61** (67-73-81-87-95) sts.

1st row: (RS). *K1. P1. Rep from * to last 5 sts. K1. P1. K3.

2nd row: Sl1P. P2. K1. *P1. K1. Rep from * to last st. P1.

3rd row: Knit to last 4 sts. P1. K3.

4th row: Sl1P. P2. Knit to end of row. Rep last 4 rows twice more (12 rows in total have been worked).

Proceed in pat as follows:

1st row: (RS). *P1. K1. Rep from * to last 5 sts. P2. K3.

2nd row: Sl1P. P2. K2. *P1. K1. Rep from * to end of row.

3rd row: *K1. P1. Rep from * to last 5 sts. K1. P1. K3.

4th row: Sl1P. P2. *K1. P1. Rep from * to end of row.

These 4 rows form Irish Moss St Pat and center front edging.

Cont in pat, dec 1 st at side edge (beg) of next row and following 12th rows until there are **57** (63-69-77-83-91) sts.

Cont even in pat until work from beg measures 19" [48 cm], ending on a WS row.

Shape armhole: Keeping cont of pat, cast off **5** (7-9-12-14-18) sts at beg of next row. **52** (56-60-65-69-73) sts. Cont even in pat until armhole measures **5** (5½-6-6-6½-6½)" [**12.5** (14-15-15-16.5-16.5) cm], ending on a RS row.

Shape lapel and neck: Next row: (WS).

Cast off **25** (26-27-29-31-33) sts. Pat to end of row. **27** (30-33-36-38-40) sts rem.

Dec 1 st at neck edge on next **5** (5-7-7-7-7) rows, then on following alt rows

4 (5-5-6-7-7) times more. **18** (20-21-23-24-26) sts rem.

Cont even in pat until armhole measures same length as Back, ending on a WS row. Cast off.

RIGHT FRONT

Cast on **61** (67-73-81-87-95) sts.

1st row: (RS). K3. P1. *K1. P1. Rep from * to last st. K1.

2nd row: *P1. K1. Rep from * to last 5 sts. P1. K1. P3.

3rd row: Sl1P. K2. P1. Knit to end of row.

4th row: Knit to last 3 sts. P3.

5th row: Sl1P. K2. P1. *K1. P1. Rep from * to last st. K1.

Rep 2nd to 5th rows once more, then 2nd to 4th rows once. (12 rows in total have been worked).

Proceed in pat as follows:

1st row: (RS). Sl1P. K2. *P1. K1. Rep from * to end of row.

2nd row: *P1. K1. Rep from * to last 3 sts. P3.

3rd row: Sl1P. K2. P2. *K1. P1. Rep from * to end of row.

4th row: *K1. P1. Rep from * to last 5 sts. K2. P3.

These 4 rows form Irish Moss St Pat and center front edging.

Cont in pat, dec 1 st at side edge (end) of next row and following 12th rows until there are **57** (63-69-77-83-91) sts.

Cont even in pat until work from beg measures 19" [48 cm], ending on a RS row.

Shape armhole: Keeping cont of pat, cast off **5** (7-9-12-14-18) sts at beg of next row. **52** (56-60-65-69-73) sts. Cont even in pat until armhole measures **5** (5½-6-6-6½-6½)" [**12.5** (14-15-15-16.5-16.5) cm], ending on a WS row.

Shape lapel and neck: Next row: (RS).

Cast off **25** (26-27-29-31-33) sts. Pat to end of row. **27** (30-33-36-38-40) sts rem. Work 1 row even in pat.

Dec 1 st at neck edge on next **5** (5-7-7-7-7) rows, then on following alt rows **4** (5-5-6-7-7) times more. **18** (20-21-23-24-26) sts rem.

Cont even in pat until armhole measures same length as Back, ending on a WS row. Cast off.

SLEEVES

Cast on **37** (37-39-39-45-47) sts.

1st row: (RS). *K1. P1. Rep from * to last st. K1.

2nd row: *P1. K1. Rep from * to last st. P1.

3rd and 4th rows: Knit.

Rep last 4 rows once more (8 rows in total have been worked).

Proceed in Irish Moss St Pat as given for Back for 6 rows.

Inc 1 st each end of next row and following 4th rows until there are **67** (71-75-75-79-79) sts, taking increased sts into pat.

Cont even in pat until Sleeve from beg measures **18** (17½-17-17-16-15)" [**45.5** (44.5-43-43-40.5-38) cm], ending on a WS row. Place markers at each end of last row. Work **6** (8-10-14-16-20) rows even in pat. Cast off.

FINISHING

Pin pieces to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth leaving cloth to dry. Sew shoulder seams. Sew in sleeves, placing rows above markers along cast off sts of Fronts and Back to form square armholes. Sew side and sleeve seams.

Collar

Cast on **101** (101-105-105-109-109) sts.

1st row: (RS). K1. *K1. P1. Rep from * to last 2 sts. K2.

2nd row: K1. *P1. K1. Rep from * to last 2 sts. P1. K1.

3rd and 4th rows: Knit.

Rep last 4 rows until Collar measures approx 5" [12.5 cm], ending on a 4th row.

Shape collar: Next row: (RS). Pat across **36** (36-37-37-38-38) sts. Cast off **29** (29-31-31-33-33) sts. Pat across **36** (36-37-
