



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately
Beg = Beginning
Ch = Chain(s)
Rem = Remaining
Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side
Sc = Single crochet
St(s) = Stitch(es)
Tog = Together
WS = Wrong side

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 14" x 24" (35.5 x 61 cm).

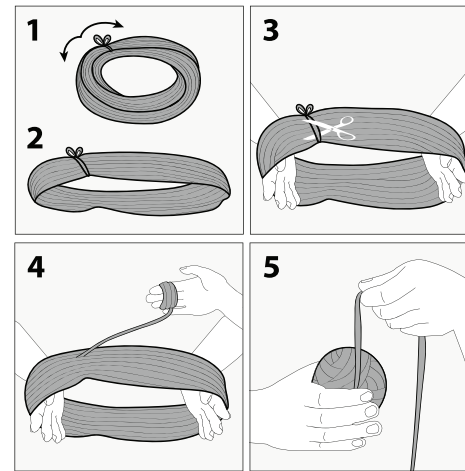
GAUGE

12 sc and 13 rows = 4" [10 cm] with Caron® One Pound™.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- Before working with Caron® x Pantone™ yarn braid, separate each link and wind into 5 separate balls for each braid.
- Each color link will be referenced by its Pantone # (see label).
- Designate each different shade of the 5 separate yarn balls as Contrast A, B, C, D and E as noted.



FRONT and BACK (make alike)

With MC, ch 74.

1st row: (RS). Working into horizontal "bump" at back of each ch, 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 73 sc.

MATERIALS

Caron® One Pound™ (16 oz/453.6 g; 812 yds/742 m)

Main Color (MC) Off White (10514) **1 ball**

Caron® x Pantone™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 127 yds/116 m)

Contrast A to E Blushing Coral (01033) **1 braid**

Contrast F Dane Gray (01003) **1 braid**

Size U.S. H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
 Stitch marker. Tapestry needle. 14" x 24" (35.5 x 61 cm) pillow form.

B - 18-3712

C - 14-4812

D - 12-5209

E - 14-1219

F - 18-0000

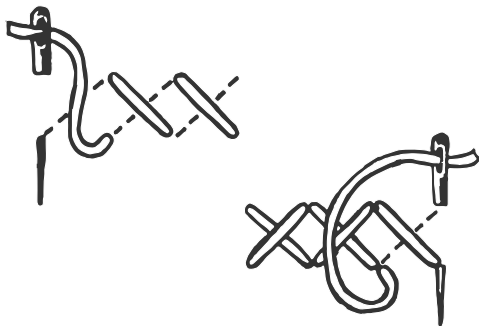
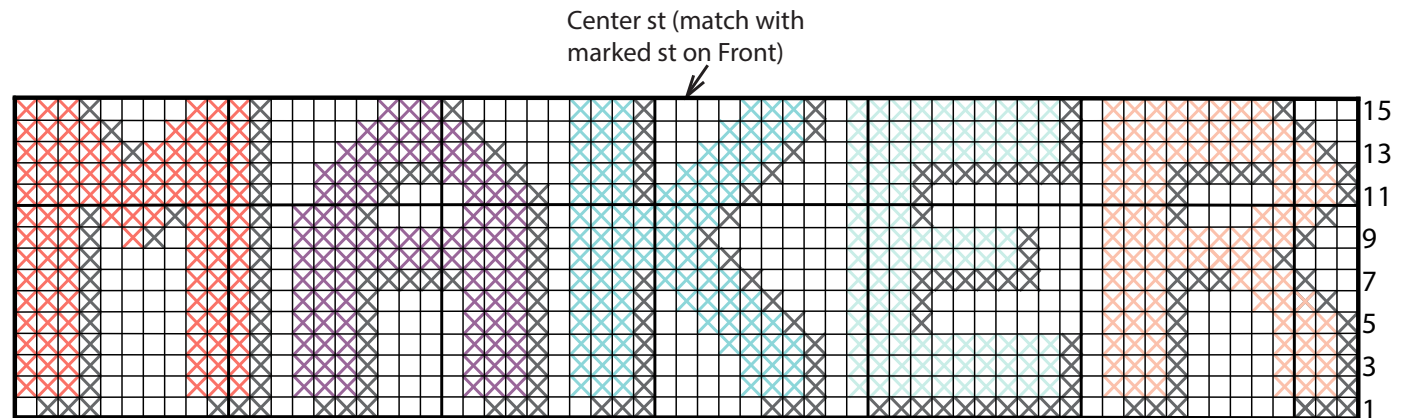
2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Turn.
Rep last row until work from beg measures 14" [35.5 cm], ending on a RS row. Fasten off.

FINISHING







Cross Stitch Embroidery:

Measure approx 4¾" [12 cm] down from top of Front and mark center st. Line up marked st with center stitch of chart and work cross stitch embroidery using A, B, C, D, E and F yarn. Each square of chart represents 1 sc.

Joining Front and Back: With MC and WS facing, sew 3 sides tog. Insert pillow form. Sew rem side closed.
