CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Ch = Chain(s)

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

St(s) = Stitch(es)

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 35" x 40" [89 x 101.5 cm].

GAUGE

13 sc and 14 rows = 4" [10 cm].

INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Blanket is worked in 4 stripes side to side to create 4 character panels.

With A, ch 113.

1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 112 sc.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each st to end of row. Turn.

3rd to 40th rows: As 2nd row. Break A. Join B.

41st to 80th rows: With B, as 2nd row. Break B. Join C.

81st to 120th rows: With C, as 2nd row. Break C. Join D.

121st to 160th rows: With D, as 2nd row. Fasten off.

MATERIALS

Bernat® Super Value™ (7 oz/197 g; 440 yds/402 m)

Contrast A Walnut (07483) **1 ball**

Contrast B True Red (53707) **1 ball**

Contrast C White (07391) **1 ball**

Contrast D Kelly (00609) **1 ball**

Contrast E Bright Yellow (00608) **1 ball**

Contrast F Black (07421) **1 ball**

Contrast G Natural (07414) **1 ball**

Size U.S. H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
Yarn needle.
