What you will need:

AUNT LYDIA'S® Classic 10:
1 ball each 421 Goldenrod A, 431 Pumpkin B, and 001 White C

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
1.65mm [US 7 steel]

Yarn needle, two white 4mm beads, two antique brass fishhook earring wires, needle-nosed pliers

GAUGE: Gauge is not critical for this project.

AUNT LYDIA'S® Classic Crochet Thread, Size 10, Art. 154 available in white & ecru 400 yd; solid color 250 yd; shaded color 300 yd balls



Candy Corn Earrings

You can celebrate the season from Halloween to Thanksgiving with these precious Candy Corn Earrings. Your local craft store can supply the findings for the earrings while you supply a little time for a great Fall accessory.

SHOP KIT

Earring measures 3/8" (2 cm) x 2" (5 cm).

Special Stitches

sc2tog = [Draw up a loop in next st] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

sc3tog = [Draw up a loop in next st] 3 times, yarn over and draw through all 4 loops on hook

EARRING (Make 2)

Candy Corn Motif (Make 4)

With **A**, ch 8.

Row 1 (Right Side): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across; ch 1, turn – 7 sc.

Row 2: Sc2tog, sc in next 3 sts, sc2tog, changing to **B** in last st; ch 3, turn – 5 sc.

Fasten off **A**, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Row 3: Dc in each st across; ch 1, turn.

Row 4: Sc in each st across, changing to **C** in last st; ch 1, turn.

Fasten off **B**, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Row 5: Sc2tog, sc in next st, sc2tog; ch 1, turn – 3 sc.

Row 6: Sc3tog. Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing. Weave in all ends except long sewing ends on Wrong Side.

FINISHING

To assemble, lay 2 motifs Wrong Sides together. Whipstitch motifs together, matching thread color to stitch color. Weave in ends.

Mist with water and pin to dry if desired.

Using photo as a guide, sew candy corn onto earring wire through bead with **A**.

ABBREVIATIONS: **A, B, C** = Color A, Color B, Color C etc; **ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch (es); **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
