INSTRUCTIONS

Note: Text in **bold** refers to knots illustrated with diagrams.

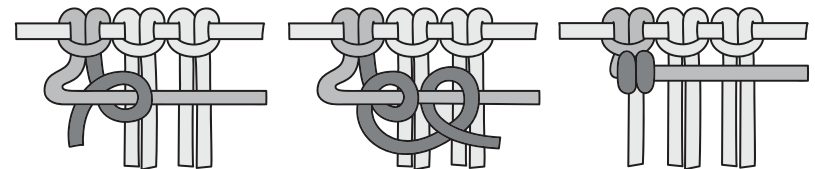
Instructions for Left-Right Double Half Hitch Row:

First cord on the left is “knot-bearer”. With next cord to the right, tie **Horizontal Left-Right Double Half Hitch Knot** onto knot-bearer. Working *left-to-right*, continue tying **Horizontal Left-Right Double Half Hitch Knots** to knot-bearer using next cord to the right of previously knotted cord to end of row as indicated in pattern.

Instructions for Right-Left Double Half Hitch Row:

Last cord on the right is “knot-bearer”. With next cord to the left, tie **Horizontal Right-Left Double Half Hitch Knot** onto knot-bearer. Working *right-to-left*, continue tying **Horizontal Right-Left Double Half Hitch Knots** to knot-bearer using next cord to the left of previously knotted cord to end of row as indicated in pattern.

MATERIALS

Bernat® Macrame™ (8.8 oz/250 g; 44 yds/40 m)
 Natural (66001) **4 balls**
 42" [106.5 cm] dowel. Hair comb for fringe.

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 36" [91.5 cm] wide x 24" [61 cm] long.

Instructions for Diamond Knot:

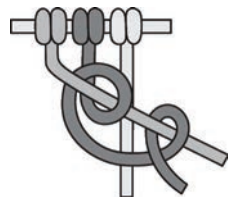


Worked over 6 cords. With third cord as knot-bearer, tie **Diagonal Right-Left Double Half Hitch Knot** with second, then first cords. With fourth cord as knot-bearer, tie **Diagonal Left-Right Double Half Hitch Knot** with fifth, then 6th cords. With center 4 cords, tie **Square Knot**. With first cord as knot-bearer, tie **Diagonal Left-Right Double Half Hitch Knot** with second, then third cords. With sixth cord as knot-bearer, tie **Diagonal Right-Left Double Half Hitch** with fifth then fourth cords. With center 4 cords, tie **Square Knot**.

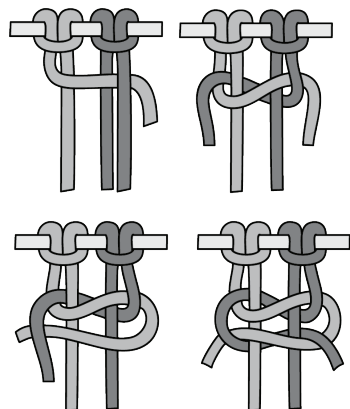
Diagonal Right-Left Double Half Hitch

Square Knot



Center Section

Cut 22 cords 118" [300 cm] long and 2 cords 128" [325 cm] long.

Fold shorter cords in half and tie using **Lark's Head Knot** across center of dowel.

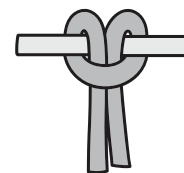
Fold longer cords so one end is 59" [150 cm] and one end is 69" [175 cm] and tie using **Lark's Head Knot** to each end of center cords previously tied to dowel, ensuring longer ends are the outer-most left and right cords. You now have 48 strands across dowel.

Working in groups of 6 cords, work 8 **Diamond Knots** across.

With left-most cord as knot-bearer, work **Left-Right Double Half Hitch Row** over next 23 cords.

With right-most cord as knot-bearer, work **Right-Left Double Half Hitch Row** over next 23 cords.

Lark's Head



Square Knot Rows

(Worked left to right across all cords).

Row 1: (**Square Knot** using first 4 cords. Skip next 4 cords) twice. **Square Knot** using next 4 cords. Skip next 8 cords. (**Square Knot** using first 4 cords. Skip next 4 cords) twice. **Square Knot** using last 4 cords.

Row 2: Skip first 2 cords. (**Square Knot** using first 4 cords. Skip next 4 cords) 4 times. **Square Knot** using next 4 cords. Leave last 2 cords unworked.

Row 3: Skip first 4 cords. (**Square Knot** using next 4 cords. Skip next 4 cords) twice. (Skip next 4 cords) twice. **Square Knot** using next 4 cords twice. Leave last 4 cords unworked.

Row 4: Skip first 6 cords. (**Square Knot** using next 4 cords. Skip next 4 cords) 4 times. **Square Knot** using next 4 cords. Leave last 6 cords unworked.

Row 5: Skip first 8 cords. (**Square Knot** using next 4 cords. Skip next 4 cords. **Square Knot** using next 4 cords. Skip next 8 cords.) twice.

Row 6: Skip first 10 cords (**Square Knot** using next 4 cords. Skip next 4 cords) 3 times. **Square Knot** using next 4 cords. Leave last 10 cords unworked.

Row 7: Skip first 12 cords. **Square Knot** using next 4 cords. Skip next 4 cords. (**Square Knot** using next 4 cords) twice. Skip next 4 cords. **Square Knot** using next 4 cords. Leave last 12 cords unworked.

Row 8: Skip first 14 cords. (**Square Knot** using next 4 cords. Skip next 4 cords) twice. **Square Knot** using next 4 cords. Leave last 14 cords unworked.

Row 9: Skip first 16 cords. **Square Knot** using next 4 cords. Skip next 8 cords. **Square Knot** using next 4 cords. Leave last 16 cords unworked.

Row 10: Skip first 18 cords. **Square Knot** using next 4 cords. Skip next 4 cords. **Square Knot** using next 4 cords. Leave last 18 cords unworked.

Row 11: Skip first 20 cords. (**Square Knot** using next 4 cords) twice. Leave last 20 cords unworked.

Row 12: Skip first 22 cords. **Square Knot** using next 4 cords. Leave last 22 cords unworked.

Trim cords to round shape as shown in photo.

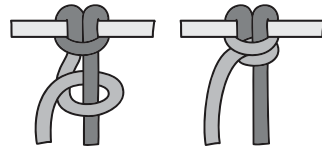
Draped Lengths

Cut 2 cords 92" [234 cm] long.

Fold cords with short end 23" [58.5 cm] and long end 69" [175.5 cm] and tie using **Lark's Head Knot** to either side of Center Section.

Having shorter cord as "knot-bearer", tie **Vertical left-right Half Hitch Knots** until work measures 15" [38 cm]. Repeat for second Draped Length.

Single Vertical Half Hitch Left-Right



Bringing ends of Draped Lengths together at center of work, tie **Square Knot** using these 4 cords.

Trim ends to 4" [10 cm].

Un-ply each loose cord by twisting cord clockwise until plies loosen, separating plies from the cut end up to knot. Comb fringe and trim evenly.

Side "X"s



1. Cut 8 cords 118" [300 cm] long.
2. Fold cords in half and tie using **Lark's Head Knot** to dowel next to Center Section. You now have 16 strands to work "X".
3. With first 8 cords, work **Left-Right Double Half Hitch Row** 5 times.
4. With remaining 8 cords, work **Right-Left Double Half Hitch Row** 5 times.
5. Tie **Horizontal Right-Left Double Half Hitch Knot** using right-most cord of first 8 cords and left-most cord of last 8 cords to join at center.
6. With first 8 cords, work **Right-Left Double Half Hitch Row** 5 times.
7. With remaining 8 cords, work **Left-Right Double Half Hitch Row** 5 times.
8. Trim ends of cords on angle as shown in photo.

9. Un-ply each loose cord by twisting cord clockwise until plies loosen, separating plies from the cut end up to knot. Comb fringe and trim evenly. Repeat Steps 1 through 9 for second "X" at opposite side of Center Section.

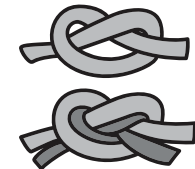
Hanging Loop

Cut 2 cords 52" [132 cm] long.

Fold cords in half and tie each using **Lark's Head Knot** to center of Xs.

Bring all 4 cords together at top center of Wall Hanging and tie **Overhand Knot**.

Overhand Knot



Trim ends of cords to 2" [5 cm].

Un-ply each loose cord by twisting cord clockwise until plies loosen, separating plies from the cut end up to knot. Comb fringe and trim evenly.
