



MATERIALS

Coats & Clark™ Button & Craft Thread

Assorted holiday cookie cutters
Assorted fabric scraps
Assorted felt scraps
Trim/ribbon scraps, at least 8" (20.32cm) long, for hangers*
Assorted buttons, pompoms, jewels, etc.
Paper-backed fusible web
Specialty shears, like pinking and/or scallop (optional)
**If you have leftover length from shortening a zipper, trim the tape close to the teeth and use as a hanger loop. Other options include baby rickrack, narrow ribbon, narrow cord, etc.*

 HAND STITCHING, CRAFTING | SKILL LEVEL: **BEGINNER**

Whether you decorate a tree or use them as package tags, these cute ornaments are so easy that they're perfect projects for kids. Grab some fabric and trim scraps and get going. Your favorite cookie cutters create the holiday shapes.

MEASUREMENTS

Depends on cookie cutters

ASSEMBLY

Note: *These are general instructions. Depending on how you choose to embellish the ornaments, additional sewing may be needed.*

1. Trace the outline of the cookie cutter onto the paper side of the fusible web. Rough-cut the shape about ¼" (.64cm) out the drawn line.
2. Following the manufacturer's instructions, fuse the web shapes to the wrong side of the center fabric.
3. Using either regular or specialty shears, trim the shape about ⅛" (.32cm) outside the drawn line.

4. Remove the paper backing and fuse the shape to a rectangle of felt at least 2" (5.08cm) larger than the shape.
5. Again, using regular or specialty shears, trim the shape about ¼"-½" (.64cm-1.27cm) outside the inner shape.
6. Hand-stitch a hanger loop to the upper edge of the ornament securing the ends on the back side.

FINISHING

1. Go crazy with embellishing! Add buttons, trims, bows, lettering, sparkles or whatever seems like fun. Hand-stitch them in place, securing the threads on the back side of the ornament.

Tips:

For write-on package tags, make the ornament center chalkboard fabric, or write the recipient's name on the ornament's fabric center using permanent marker. Tags are reusable from year to year.

If you're giving these as a gift, use your favorite recipe and make cookies in the same shapes to accompany the ornaments.
