KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

Cont = Continue

K = Knit

P = Purl

Pat = Pattern

PM = Place marker

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

RS = Right side

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

MEASUREMENTS

Version 1: Approx 3" [7.5 cm] tall and 2½" [6.5 cm] wide (excluding sleeves).

Version 2: Approx 2½" [6.5 cm] tall and 2½" [6.5 cm] wide (excluding sleeves).

With pair of needles, cast on 18 sts.

Front: 1st row: (RS). K2. *P2. K2. Rep from * to end of row.

2nd row: P2. *K2. P2. Rep from * to end of row.

Rep last 2 rows (K2. P2) ribbing for 3" [7.5 cm], ending on a WS row.

GAUGE

18 sts and 24 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking stitch.

Shape Neck: 1st row: (RS). K2. P2. K2. Cast off 6 sts. K2. P2. K2.

2nd row: P2. K2. P2. Cast on 6 sts. P2. K2. P2.

INSTRUCTIONS

Version 1: Ribbed Turtleneck Sweater

Body

Note: Front and Back are worked in one piece from bottom edge of Front to bottom edge of Back.

Back: Cont in K2. P2. ribbing until Back measures same as Front ending on a RS row.

Cast off in ribbing (WS).

MATERIALS

Red Heart® Super Saver® (7 oz/198 g; 364 yds/333 m)

Version 1: Ribbed Turtleneck Sweater

Aran (0313) **1 ball** (will make 12 Sweaters)

Version 2: Striped Turtleneck Sweater

Contrast A Burgundy (0376) **1 ball**

Contrast B Aran (0313) **1 ball**

Note: 1 ball of Contrast A and B will make 32 Sweaters.

Size U.S. 6 (4 mm) knitting needles. Set of 4 size U.S. 6 (4 mm) double-pointed knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.** 4 split-ring stitch markers.

Sleeves

PM 2" [5 cm] up from bottom edge on either side of both Back and Front. With RS facing and pair of needles, pick up and knit 10 sts evenly spaced along left side edge between markers.

1st row: (WS). P2. *K2. P2. Rep from * to end of row.

2nd row: K2. *P2. K2 Rep from * to end of row.

Rep last 2 rows until Sleeve measures 2" [5 cm] ending on a RS row. Cast off in ribbing (WS).

Turtleneck: With RS facing, double-pointed needles and beg at left neck edge, pick up and knit 16 sts around neckline opening. Divide sts on 3 needles. Join in rnd, PM on first st.

1st rnd: *P2. K2. Rep from * around.

Rep last rnd until Turtleneck measures 1" [2.5 cm].

Cast off in ribbing. Fold turtleneck over.

FINISHING

Fold work bringing cast on and cast off rows of Body to meet. Sew side and Sleeve seams.

Version 2: Striped Turtleneck Sweater

Note: Front and Back are worked in one piece from bottom edge of Front to bottom edge of Back.

Stripe Pat

With A: 2 rows.

With B: 2 rows.

These 4 rows form Stripe Pat.

Body

With pair of needles and A, cast on 12 sts.

Front: 1st row: (RS). *K1. P1. Rep from * to end of row.

2nd row: As first row.

3rd row: With B, knit.

4th row: With B, purl.

One rep of Stripe Pat is complete. Cont in Stripe Pat in stocking st until work from beg measures approx 2½" [6.5 cm], ending on a WS row with B.

Shape Neck: 1st row: (RS). With A, K4. Cast off 4 sts. K4.

2nd row: P4. Cast on 4 sts. P4.

Back: Cont in Stripe Pat in stocking st until Back measures same length as Front, ending on a WS row with B. Break B.

Next row: (RS). With A, knit.

Next 2 rows: *K1. P1. Rep from * to end of row.

Cast off in ribbing.

Sleeves

PM 1¾" [4.5 cm] up from bottom edge on either side of both Back and Front. With RS facing, pair of needles and A, pick up and knit 10 sts evenly spaced along left side edge between markers.

Work Stripe Pat in stocking st until Sleeve measures 1½ [4 cm], ending on a WS row with B. Break B.

Next row: (RS). With A, knit.

Next 2 rows: *K1. P1. Rep from * to end of row.

Cast off in ribbing.

Turtleneck

With RS facing, double-pointed needles and beg at left neck edge, pick up and knit 12 sts around neck edge. Divide sts on 3 needles. Join in rnd, PM on first st.

1st rnd: *K1. P1. Rep from * around.

Rep last rnd until Turtleneck measures 1" [2.5 cm].

Cast off in ribbing. Fold Turtleneck over.

FINISHING

Fold work bringing cast on and cast off rows of Body to meet. Sew side and Sleeve seams.
