What you will need:

RED HEART® Boutique Treasure™:
2 balls each 1913 Spectrum A and
1920 Floral B

Susan Bates® Knitting Needles:
5.5 mm [US 9]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 16 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 20
rows = 4" [10 cm] in Stockinette
Stitch. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use
any size needle to obtain the
gauge.

Striped Shaded Scarf

Only two colors of this gorgeous yarn are used to knit this stunning scarf! Edges are done in garter stitch to prevent rolling edges on this unique scarf.

SHOP KIT

Scarf measures: 8" [20 cm] wide x 80" [203 cm] long

NOTES

Scarf is worked back and forth in rows.

Join a new ball of yarn when there are approximately 6" (15 cm) of yarn left from the old ball, also leaving a 6" (15 cm) tail of yarn with the joined yarn. Weave these ends in neatly on the wrong side of the fabric in a zigzag pattern for a few inches, and then trim off excess.

SCARF

With A, cast on 32 sts.

Row 1 (Right Side): Knit across row.

Row 2 (Wrong Side): Knit across row.

Repeat Rows 1-2 5 times—12 rows total.

Change to B

Row 1 (Right Side): Knit across row.

Row 2 (Wrong Side): K6, p20, k6.

Repeat Rows 1-2 five times—12 rows total.

Repeat the above stripe sequence pattern until scarf measures 80" [203 cm] or desired length, ending on A stripe sequence so ends match.

Bind off all sts loosely. Draw through remaining st twice; fasten securely.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Lightly block scarf.

ABBREVIATIONS

A = Color A; B = Color B; cm = centimeters; k = knit mm = millimeters; p = purl; St st = Stockinette stitch; st(s) = stitch (es).
