

BERNAT® GARTER STITCH KNIT BASKETS | KNIT



MATERIALS

Bernat® Blanket Extra™ (10.5 oz/300 g; 97 yds/87 m)

Small: Burgundy Plum (27005) **1 ball**

Medium: Burnt Rose (27004) **1 ball**

Large: Gray Orchid (27012) **1 ball**

Size U.S. 17 (12.75 mm) circular knitting needle 24" [61 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

ABBREVIATIONS

Alt = Alternate

Approx = Approximately

Cont = Continue

K = Knit

Pat = Pattern

Rem = Remaining

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tog = Together



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

MEASUREMENTS

Small: Approx 10½" [26.5 cm] diameter x 9" [23 cm] tall.

Medium: Approx 12½" [32 cm] diameter x 6" [15 cm] tall.

Large: Approx 14" [35.5 cm] diameter x 11½" [29 cm] tall.

GAUGE

4.5 sts and 9 rows = 4" [10 cm] in garter stitch.

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (). Numbers for each size are shown in the same color throughout the pattern. When only one number is given in black, it applies to all sizes.

Cast on **16** (**14-21**) sts. **Do not join.** Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:

****1st row:** (RS). Knit.

2nd row: K**15** (**13-20**). **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked.

3rd and alt rows: Knit.

4th row: K**14** (**12-19**). **Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked.

6th row: K**13** (**11-18**). **Turn** Leave rem sts unworked.

Cont in same manner, working 1 st less every following alt row until row: "**K10 (7-13). Turn.** Leave rem sts unworked" is complete.

Next row: Knit.

Next row: Knit all **16** (**14-21**) sts.**

Rep from ** to ** 5 times more.
Cast off.

FINISHING

Sew cast on and cast-off edges tog.
