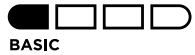

What you will need:

RED HEART® Pomp-a-Doodle™: 1 ball each 220 Chickadee and 710 Blossom

- White craft felt
- Yellow craft felt
- White mini pompoms
- 6 Mm googly eyes
- Small white feathers
- Tacky craft glue
- Clothespin scissors
- Wooden skewers or dowels

GAUGE: Gauge is not critical for this project.

BUY YARN



RED HEART® Pomp-a-Doodle™, Art E875 available in solid and multicolor 3.5 oz (100 g), 14 yd (13 m) balls



Bunny and Chick Party Decorations

These chick and bunny inspired decorations are the perfect touch for any springtime celebration!



BUNNY DECORATION

Step 1: Cut one pompom from yarn and cut two 1½" [4 cm] ears from white craft felt.

Step 2: Pull pompom yarn apart to create space for ears. Apply glue in the space.



Step 3: Press base of ears into glue to secure.



Step 4: Pull pompom yarn apart to create space for tail. Apply glue in the space.



Step 5: Press small white pompom into glue to adhere and allow to dry.



Step 6: Glue completed pompom onto skewer.

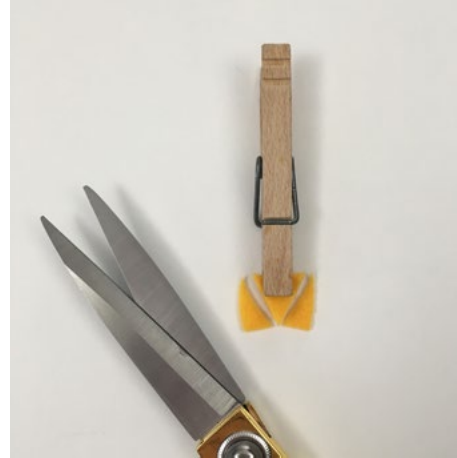

Step 2: Apply craft glue across middle of rectangle.



Step 4: Cut a "V" in felt to create triangle for beak.

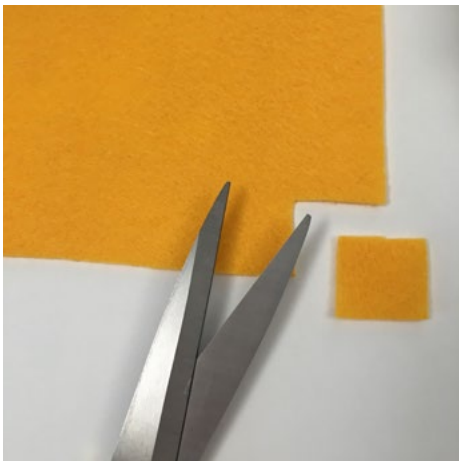


Step 6: Separate pompom yarn to create space for beak. Apply glue in the space. Press beak/eyes into glue.



CHICK DECORATION

Step 1: Cut one pompom from yarn and cut 1" [2.5 cm] x 1½" [4 cm] rectangle from yellow craft felt.



Step 3: Fold rectangle in half and hold closed with clothespin until glue is dry.



Step 5: Release clothespin. Glue googly eyes on top of beak along fold line.



Step 7: Apply glue to either side of pompom where garland yarn connects.

Step 8: Cut two ¼" [6 mm] sections of feather for each chick's wings.



Step 10: Glue completed pompom onto skewer.



Step 9: Push feathers into glue on either side of pompom.
