What you will need:

RED HEART® Boutique Unforgettable®: 1 ball 3945 Parrot

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 6 mm [US]-10]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 17 sts = 5" (12.5 cm); 13½ rows = 5" (12.5 cm) in half double crochet (hdc). **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.**



Red Heart® Boutique Unforgettable®, Art. E793 available in 3.5oz (100 g), 270 yd (247 m) balls



Cowl measures 20½" (52 cm) circumference around neck, and 10" (25.5 cm) high.

Notes

Cowl is worked back and forth in rows. Short edges are then crocheted together to form a circle. Edging is worked around both edges of circle.

COWL

Ch 35.

Row 1: Hdc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across—34 hdc.

Row 2 (right side): Ch 1, turn, working in back loops only, hdc in each st across.

Row 3: Ch 1, turn, working in front loops only, hdc in each st across.

Repeat Rows 2 and 3 until you have worked a total of 70 rows.

Seaming Row (wrong side): Turn, hold first and last rows with right sides together and stitches matching, working through both thicknesses, slip st in each st across to join piece into a circle. Do not fasten off.

Turn piece so that right side is facing out.

Edging (right side): Ch 1, work 2 sc in the end of every other row all the way around; join with slip st in first sc—70 sc. Fasten off.

With right side facing, draw up a loop of yarn in seam on opposite edge of cowl and repeat Edging.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; **hdc** = half double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es).

Easy Tropical Cowl

Using this amazing multi-shaded yarn means you crochet this cowl that looks advanced, but is actually quick and easy.

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
