## What you will need:

### RED HEART® Super Saver®:

1 skein each 376 Burgundy A, 3941 Chile B, 3950 Charcoal C, 400 Grey Heather D, 3946 Razzle E, 360 Café Latte F, 726 Coral G

### Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:

5.5mm [US I-9]

Yarn needle, three 18" (45.5 cm)

knife edge square pillow forms

**GAUGE:** Rounds 1-3 = 4" (10 cm)

in diameter. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.**

Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

# Circle in the Square Pillows

*This colorful granny starts out round and then becomes a square. By just changing the order of the colors, you can crochet the perfect trio of pillows.*

Pillow measures 18" x 18" (45.5 x 45.5 cm)

## Notes

There is enough yarn to make 3 pillows.

Make 2 squares in each color combination as follows:

**Pillow 1:** 2 rounds in C, 1 round in G, 2 rounds in E, 2 rounds in C, 2 rounds in D, 2 rounds in A, 2 rounds in B, 1 round in F, 1 round in G

**Pillow 2:** 2 rounds in A, 1 round in F, 2 rounds in D, 2 rounds in B, 2 rounds in C, 2 rounds in E, 2 rounds in F, 1 round in G, 1 round in D

**Pillow 3:** 2 rounds in B, 1 round in D, 2 rounds in A, 2 rounds in F, 2 rounds in G, 2 rounds in B, 2 rounds in C, 1 round in E, 1 round in F

## PILLOWS

### Square (make 2 in each color combination)

**Note:** All rounds are worked with right side facing.

Ch 4; join with slip st in first ch to form a ring.

**Round 1 (right side):** Ch 1, 12 sc in ring; join with slip st in first sc—12 sc.

**Round 2:** Ch 4 (counts as first dc and ch 1 here and throughout), \*dc in next sc, ch 1; repeat from \* around; join with slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch-4—12 dc and 12 ch-1 spaces. Fasten off.

**Round 3:** Join next color with slip st in any dc, ch 4, dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1, \*dc in next dc, ch 1, dc in next ch-1 space, ch 1; join with slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch 4—24 dc and 24 ch-1 spaces. Fasten off.

**Round 4:** Join next color with slip st in any dc, ch 3, (counts as first dc here and throughout), dc in each dc and ch-1 space; join with slip st in top of beginning ch 3—48 dc.

**Round 5:** Ch 5 (counts as first dc and ch 2), skip next dc, dc in next dc, \*ch 2, skip next dc, dc in next dc; repeat from \* to beginning ch-5, ch 2; join with slip st in 3rd ch of beginning ch-5—24 dc and 24 ch-2 spaces. Fasten off.

**Round 6:** Join next color with slip st in any ch-2 space, ch 3, dc in same space, \*ch 1, 2 dc in next ch-2 space; repeat from \* to beginning ch-3, ch 1; join with slip st in top of beginning ch 3—48 dc and 24 ch-1 spaces.

**Note:** In Round 7, count each dc and each ch-1 space as a stitch. When you are instructed to skip or work into a stitch, the stitch may be a dc or it may be a ch-1 space.

**Round 7:** Slip st in next dc and ch-1 space, ch 4 (counts as tr), (tr, ch 3, 2 tr) in same ch-1 space (first corner made), \*[ch 1, skip next st, dc in next st] twice, [ch 1, skip next st, sc in next st] 4 times, [ch 1, skip next st, dc in next st] twice, ch 1, skip next st, [2 tr, ch 3, 2 tr] in next ch-1 space (next corner made); repeat from \* twice, [ch 1, skip next st, dc in next st] twice, [ch 1, skip next st, sc in next st] 4 times, [ch 1, skip next st, dc in next st] twice, ch 1, skip next st; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-4—16 tr, 36 ch-1 spaces, and 4 corner ch-3 spaces. Fasten off.

**Round 8:** Join next color with slip st in any corner ch-3 space, ch 3, (dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in same ch-3 space, \*dc in each st and ch-1 space to next corner, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in corner ch-3 space; repeat from \* twice, dc in each st and ch-1 space to beginning ch-3; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-3—100 dc.

**Round 9:** Slip st in next dc and corner ch-3 space, ch 3, (dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in same ch-3 space, \*dc in each dc to next ch-3 space, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in each corner ch-3 space; repeat from \* twice, dc in each dc to beginning ch-3; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-3—116 dc. Fasten off.

**Round 10:** Join next color with slip st in any corner ch-3 space, ch 3, (dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in same ch-3 space, skip next dc, \*(2 dc in next dc, skip next dc) to next corner, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in next corner ch-3 space, skip next dc; repeat from \* twice, (2 dc in next dc, skip next

dc) to beginning ch-3; join with slip st in top of beginning ch 3—128 dc.

**Round 11:** Slip st in next dc and corner ch-3 space, ch 3, (dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same ch-3 space, \*[2 dc in space between next two 2-dc groups] 15 times, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in next corner ch-3 space; repeat from \* twice, [2 dc in space between next two 2-dc groups] 15 times to beginning ch-3; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-3—136 dc. Fasten off.

**Round 12:** Join next color with slip st in any corner ch-3 space, ch 4, (tr, ch 3, 2 tr) in same ch-3 space, \*tr in each dc to next corner ch-3 space, (2 tr, ch 3, 2 tr) in next corner ch-3 space; repeat from \* twice, tr in each dc to beginning ch-3; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-4—152 tr.

**Round 13:** Slip st in next tr and corner ch-3 space, ch 3, (dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in same ch-3 space, ch 1, dc between first 2 tr, [ch 1, dc between next 2 tr] 18 times, \*ch 1, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in next ch-3 space, [ch 1, dc between next 2 tr] 19 times; repeat from \* twice, ch 1; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-3—92 dc and 76 ch-1 spaces. Fasten off.

**Round 14:** Join next color with slip st in any corner ch-3 space, ch 3, (dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in same ch-3 space, \*dc in each dc and ch-1 space to next corner ch-3 space, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in next corner ch-3 space around; repeat from \* twice, dc in each dc and ch-1 space to beginning ch-3; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-3—184 dc. Fasten off.

**Round 15:** Join next color with slip st in any corner ch-3 space, ch-3, (dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in same ch-3 space, \*dc in each dc to next corner ch-3 space, (2 dc, ch 3, 2 dc) in next corner ch-3 space around; repeat from \* twice, dc in each dc to beginning ch-3; join with slip st in top of beginning ch-3—200 dc. Fasten off.

## Assembly

With wrong sides of 2 identical squares held together and working through both layers, join yarn of Round 15 with slip st to any dc, slip st in each dc and ch-space, working 3 slip st in each corner, until 3 sides are joined. Insert pillow form, slip st in each remaining dc and ch-space to first slip st; join with slip st in first st. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**A, B, C** = Color A, Color B, Color C etc.; **ch** = chain; **dc** = double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **sp(s)** = space(s); **st(s)** = stitch(es); **tr** = treble (triple) crochet; **()** = work directions in parentheses into same st; **[ ]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; **\*** = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.
