## What you will need:

**RED HEART® Heart & Sole:** 1 ball 3800 Blue

**Double Pointed Knitting**  
**Needles:** 1 set 3.75 mm [US 5]

¾" [19mm] button, stitch marker, yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 19 sts = 4" [10 cm]  
34 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Stockinette stitch. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size needles to obtain the tension/gauge.

# Handy Business Card Case

Pull out your knitted business card case and you'll quickly find out if your new acquaintance is also a knitter! It's perfect for giving to congratulate someone on their new job or for keeping your own business cards handy.

Case measures 3½" [9 cm] x 2½" [6.5 cm]

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

**K1-f/b:** Knit 1 front and back (increase)  
- Knit the front of the stitch as normal, leave the yarn on the needle and knit into the back of the same stitch to increase by one stitch.

## CARD CASE

Cast on 5 sts.

**Row 1 (Wrong Side):** Working back and forth in rows, purl.

**Row 2:** K1, k1-f/b, k1, k1-f/b, k1 – 7 sts.

**Row 3:** Purl.

**Row 4:** K1, k1-f/b, k3, k1-f/b, k1 – 9 sts.

**Row 5:** Purl.

**Row 6:** K1, k1-f/b, k1, cast off 3 sts, k1-f/b, k1 – 8 sts.

**Row 7:** P4, cast on 3 sts, p4 – 11 sts.

**Row 8:** K1, k1-f/b, k7, k1-f/b, k1 – 13 sts.

**Row 9:** Purl.

**Row 10:** K1, k1-f/b, k9, k1-f/b, k1 – 15 sts.

**Row 11:** Purl.

**Row 12:** K1, k1-f/b, k11, k1-f/b, k1 – 17 sts.

**Row 13:** Purl.

**Row 14:** K1, k1-f/b, k13, k1-f/b, k1 – 19 sts.

**Row 15:** Purl.

**Row 16:** K19, cast on 19 sts – 38 sts.

Divide sts evenly around double pointed needles. Join to work in rounds, taking care not to twist sts. Place marker for beginning of round.

Working in the round, knit until piece measures 2½" [6.5 cm] from Row 16.

Cast off.

## FINISHING

Sew lower edge closed. Sew button on case opposite buttonhole. Weave in ends.

## Abbreviations

**cm** = centimeters; **k** = knit; **mm** = millimeters; **st(s)** = stitch(es).
