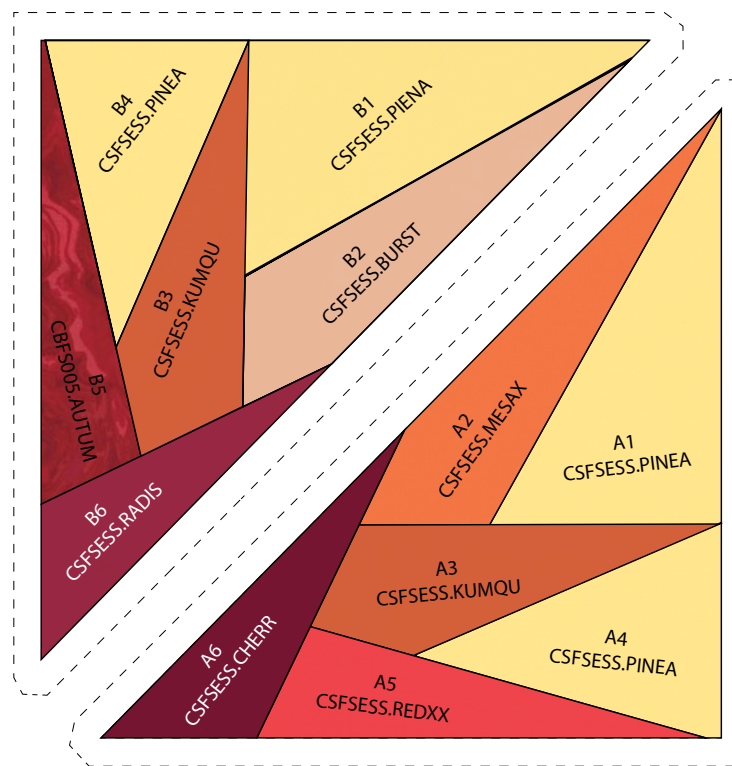
Instructions

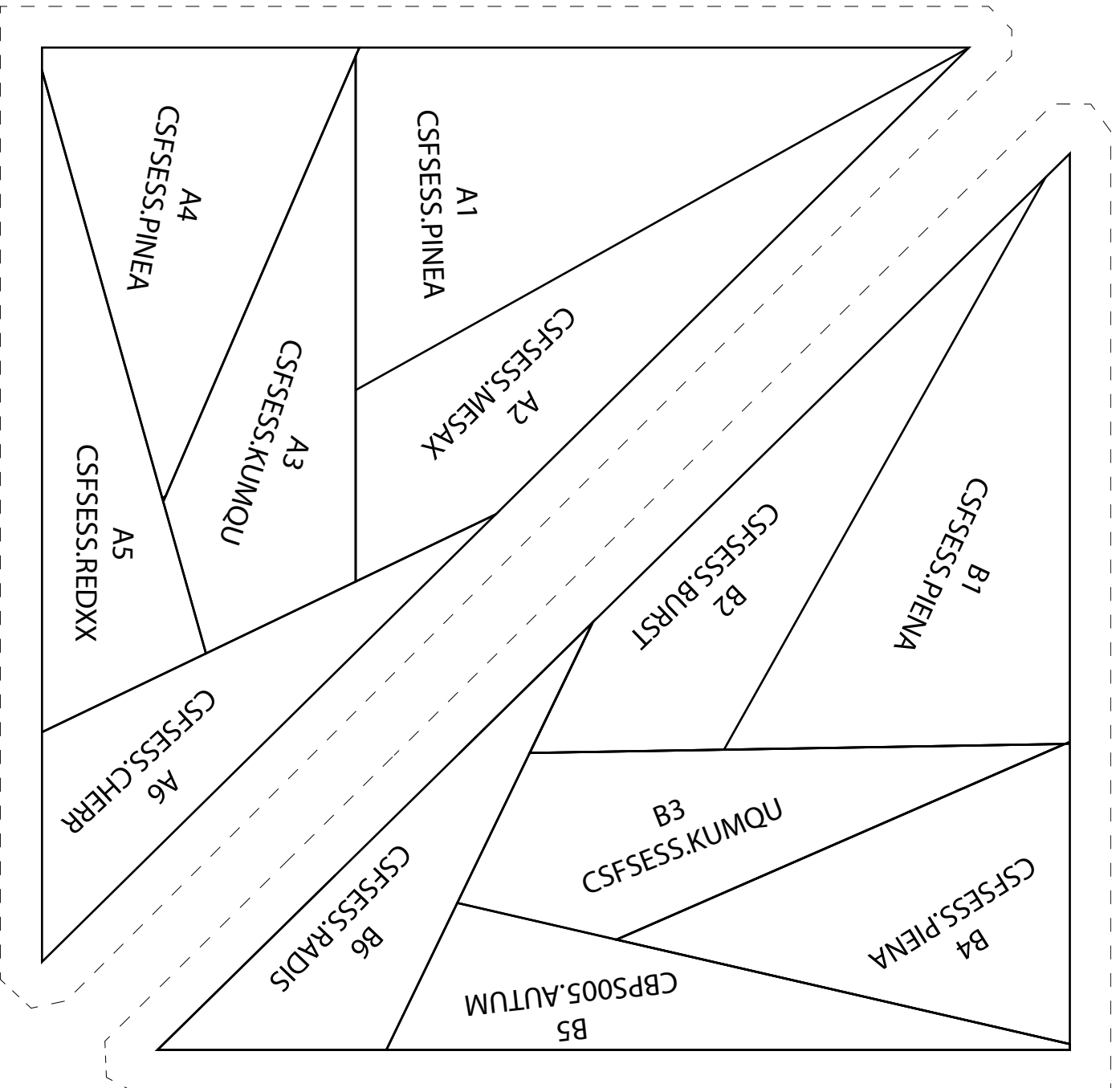
Note: Cutting template on page 3

1. Roughly cut fabric to cover each labeled area of the foundation sections; remember that you'll need four of each piece. Cut the fabric at least ½" (1.3cm) larger on each side than the corresponding foundation area. Refer to the foundation labels for fabric placement.
2. Cut the foundation sections apart before you begin sewing. Place fabric piece A1 right side up on the unmarked side of the paper foundation for section A, making sure that it extends beyond the perimeter of foundation area A1 on all sides. It's helpful to hold the foundation up to a bright light so the fabric is visible from the printed side of the paper.
3. Place piece A2 on the unprinted side of the foundation, right side up, positioning it so that it covers area A2. Carefully flip piece A2 over onto piece A1 so that the fabrics are right sides together, making sure that fabric from both pieces extends at least ¼" (.6cm) beyond the seamline. Pin the pieces in place. With the foundation printed-side up, sew on the line between areas A1 and A2.
4. Working on the unprinted side of the foundation, flip fabric A2 over so that its right side is facing up, and check again to make sure that fabric covers the entire foundation area. Flip fabric A2 back onto fabric A1 and trim the seam allowances to about ¼" (.6cm). Smooth fabric A2 back over its foundation area and press.
5. Repeat steps 3 and 4 for the remaining areas of foundation A; make four. Repeat the entire process to fill four of foundation B with fabric. When you have completed piecing each section, trim the perimeter seam allowances to ¼" (.6cm).
TIP: To stabilize the outer edges of each pieced section, stitch just outside the seamline around the section perimeter before trimming the foundations.

7. Following the block diagram above, sew one each of sections A and B together to make a quarter block; make four. Sew the four quarters together to make the block. Carefully tear the paper from the back of the block and press.
