



 KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

### MEASUREMENTS

Approx 50½ x 60½" [128.5 x 153.5 cm].

### GAUGE

8 sts and 12 rows = 4" [10 cm] in pat holding 3 strands of yarn tog.

### MATERIALS

Caron® One Pound™ (16 oz/453.6 g; 812 yds/742 m)

**Contrast A** Soft Grey Mix (10616)      **2 balls**

**Contrast B** Med Grey Mix (10617)      **2 balls**

**Contrast C** Dark Grey Mix (10618)      **2 balls**

Size U.S. 15 (10 mm) circular knitting needle 40" [101.5 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch marker.

### ABBREVIATIONS:

**Approx** =  
Approximate(ly)

**Cont** = Continue(ity)

**K** = Knit

**Pat** = Pattern

**P** = Purl

**Rep** = Repeat(ing)

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**Tog** = Together

### INSTRUCTIONS

#### Stripe Pat

26 rows with 3 strands of A.

26 rows with 2 strands of A and 1 strand of B.

26 rows with 1 strand of A and 2 strands of B.

26 rows with 3 strands of B.

26 rows with 2 strands of B and 1 strand of C.

26 rows with 1 strand of B and 2 strands of C.

26 rows with 3 strands of C.

These 182 rows form Stripe Pat.

**Note:** Wind each ball of yarn into 3 equal size balls for ease of working.

With 3 strands of A held tog, cast on 101 sts. **Do not** join. Working back and forth across needle in rows, proceed as follows:

**1st row:** \*P2. K2. Rep from \* to last st. P1.

**2nd row:** \*K2. P2. Rep from \* to last st. K1.

Rep last 2 rows for Ridge St Pat. First 2 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.

Cont in Ridge St and Stripe Pat until 182 rows of Stripe Pat are complete.

With 3 strands of C, cast off in pat.
