## What you will need:

**RED HEART® Scrubby™:** 1 ball each 241 Duckie **A**, 501 Ocean **B**, 709 Bubblegum **C**, 10 Coconut **D**, 12 Black **E**

**Susan Bates® Circular Knitting Needles:** 5.5 mm [US 9] 16" [40 cm]

Stitch Marker, yarn needle

**GAUGE:** 18 sts = 4" [10 cm]; 16 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Garter Stitch (knit every row). Gauge is not critical for this pattern.

**CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needle to obtain the gauge.**

# Scrubby Monster Mitt

Make wash time more fun with a colorful one-eyed monster mitt! It's perfect for washing up in the tub or shower, at the bathroom sink, or helping with the dishes in the kitchen. Keep it fresh and clean by machine washing.

**Mitt measures:** 9" [23 cm] long x 4" [10 cm] wide.

## SPECIAL STITCHES

**KFB** = Knit front and back of stitch (increase). knit 1 stitch in the front, then in the back loop. This is also called a Bar Increase

**K2TOG** = Knit 2 stitches together (decrease).

**Make 1** = Make 1 stitch (increase). Lift strand between needles to left-hand needle and knit strand through the back loop, twisting it to prevent a hole.

## MONSTER MITT

With **A**, cast on 48 sts. Join, being careful not to twist stitches and place stitch marker to mark beginning of round.

**Round 1:** \*K2, P2\*, repeat from \* to \* to end of round.

**Next Rounds:** Repeat Round 1 until piece measures 2" [5 cm] from cast on edge.

**Next Rounds:** Knit every round for 1" [2.5 cm], cut yarn.

**Next Rounds:** Change to **B**, knit every round until pieces measures 6" [15 cm] from cast on edge, cut yarn.

**Next Rounds:** Change to **C**, knit every round until piece measures 9" [23 cm] from cast on edge.

**Next Round:** Bind off all stitches loosely.

## EYE

With **E**, cast on 8 stitches.

**Row 1:** KFB in each stitch — 16 sts.

**Row 2:** KFB, \*K1, KFB\*, ending with K1 — 24 sts, cut yarn.

**Row 3:** Change to **D**. KFB, \*K2, KFB\*, ending with K2 — 32 sts.

**Row 4:** Bind off all stitches loosely. With Yarn Needle, join ends together and sew Eye into a circle, set aside.



## MOUTH

With **E**, cast on 12 stitches.

**Row 1:** Knit.

**Row 2:** Bind off all stitches loosely.

Using **D**, pick up and knit 4 stitches on each side of mouth.

**Row 1:** Knit 4 stitches.

**Row 2:** K2tog, knit — 3 sts.

**Row 3:** K2tog, knit — 2 sts.

**Row 4:** K2tog — 1 st.

Cut yarn and thread through remaining stitch and tie off.

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## FINISHING

Using Yarn Needle, Sew top seam together and weave in all tails and loose ends.

## EYE

With Yarn Needle, sew “Eye” to top/center of mitt. Center the “Eye” over **B** and **C** in the middle of the mitt. Use photo as a guide for placement.

## MOUTH

With Yarn Needle, sew “Mouth” to middle of mitt over **B**. Center “Mouth” under the “Eye”, about 1½” [3.8 cm] apart. Use photo as a guide for placement.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**A** = Ducky; **B** = Ocean; **C** = Bubblegum;  
**D** = Coconut; **E** = Licorice; **cm** =  
centimeters; **K** = knit; **mm** = millimeters;  
**P** = purl; **St st** = stockinette stitch; **St(s)**  
= stitch(es); \* = repeat whatever follows  
the \* as indicated.
