

BERNAT® LITTLE RIDGE STRIPED KNIT CUSHION | KNIT



MATERIALS

Bernat® Blanket Breezy™ (8.8 oz/250 g; 530 yds/485 m)
Citron Splash (70003) **1 ball**

Size U.S. 8 (5 mm) circular knitting needle 24" [61 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.** 14" x 24" [35.5 x 61 cm] pillow form. Stitch marker.

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

Kfb = Increase 1 stitch by knitting into front and back of next stitch

P2tog = Purl next 2 stitches together

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tog = Together



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 14" x 24" [35.5 x 61 cm].

GAUGE

16 sts and 20 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking stitch.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes: Cushion is worked in the round, from side-to-side, with 2 end seams. Place marker at beg of rnd for easier counting.

Optional Centering of Stripes on Cushion (as shown in photo): Each ball of **Bernat® Blanket Breezy™** contains color sections in varying lengths.

Label each color change in the ball as follows:

A = 87½ yds [80 m] section

B = 44 yds [40 m] section

C = 16½ yds [15 m] section

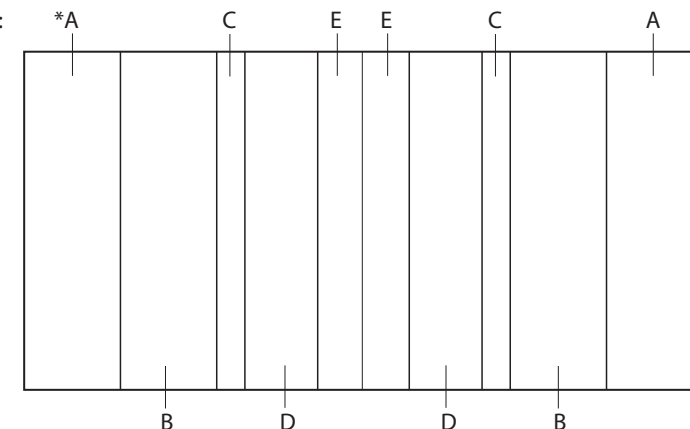
D = 33 yds [30 m] section

E = 22 yds [20 m] section

Establish starting point of first **A** section in ball. Divide this **A** section in half, leaving approx 44 yds [40 m] attached to the ball. This marks the starting point of your yarn and the correct section for cast on edge.

You can add cut yarn back to end of ball, maintaining color change repeat, to avoid waste.

*To find starting point of yarn: Trim (A) longest color change to leave approx 44 yds [40 m] attached to the ball.



BERNAT® LITTLE RIDGE STRIPED KNIT CUSHION | KNIT

Cast on 108 sts. Join for working in rnd, being careful not to twist and placing marker at first st.

1st to 6th rnds: Knit.

7th rnd: *Kfb. Rep from * around. 216 sts.

8th rnd: *P2tog. Rep from * around. 108 sts.

Rep 1st to 8th rnds until work from beg measures approx 24" [61 cm], ending on a 6th rnd.

Cast off.

FINISHING

Sew cast on edge tog. Insert pillow form. Sew cast off edge tog.
