



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Begin(ning)

Ch = Chain(s)

Pat = Pattern

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

Scbl = Single crochet in back loop only

Sc2(3)togtbl = Draw up a loop in back loop only of each of next 2 (3) sc. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook

Sl st = Slip stitch

Sp(s) = Space(s)

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tog = Together

WS = Wrong side

Yoh = Yarn over hook

MATERIALS

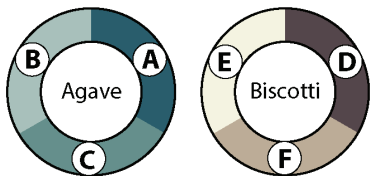
Bernat® Blanket™ O'Go™ (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)

Agave (42010)

3 O'Gos

Biscotti (42002)

3 O'Gos



Size U.S. M/13 (9 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch marker. T-pins. Yarn needle. 5" [12.5 cm] piece of cardboard for tassels.

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 50 x 59" [127 x 150 cm], excluding tassels.

GAUGE

7.5 sts and 6 rows = 4" [10 cm] in pat.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull tie to remove.

- For this pattern, colors can be easily separated by gently pulling apart and cutting at the color transition. Each color is ready to use.
- Follow color guide shown in Materials section for each O'Go (Contrast A, B, C, D, E and F). You may find it helpful to place each color section in its own resealable (zip lock) bag and label each bag – A, B, C, D, E, F.
- Blanket is made of 5 Panels, worked on the diagonal.
- Panels are reversible and will alternate to create final pattern when joined,
- To join new colors work to last loops on hook of previous color. Yoh with new color and proceed.

PANEL 1

With B, ch 2.

1st row: 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 1. 2 scbl in first sc. 1 scbl in next sc. 2 scbl in last sc. Turn. 5 sts.

3rd to 6th rows: Ch 1. 2 scbl in first sc. 1 scbl in each sc to last sc. 2 scbl in last sc. Join Contrast A. Break B. Turn. 13 sts.

7th to 12th rows: With A, as 3rd row. 25 sts. Join B at end of 12th row. Break A.

13th row: With B, ch 1. 2 scbl in first sc. 1 scbl in each sc to last 2 sc. Sc2togtbl. PM on last st. Turn. 25 sts.

14th row: Ch 1. Sc2togtbl. 1 scbl in each sc to last sc. 2 scbl in last sc. 25 sts. Turn.

15th to 18th rows: Rep last 2 rows twice more. Join A at end of 18th row. Break B. Turn.

19th to 24th rows: With A, rep 13th to 18th rows. Join B at end of 24th row. Break A. Turn.

25th to 66th rows: Rep 13th to 24th rows 3 times more, then 13th to 18th rows once.

67th to 72nd rows: With A, ch 1. Sc2togtbl. 1 scbl in each sc to last 2 sts. Sc2togtbl. Turn.

Join B at end of 72nd row. Break A. 13 sts rem.

73rd to 77th rows: With B, ch 1. Sc2togtbl. 1 scbl in each sc to last 2 sts. Sc2togtbl. Turn. 3 sts rem at end of 77th row.

78th row: With B, ch 1. Sc3togtbl. Fasten off.

PANEL 2

Work as for Panel 1 substituting E for B and C for A.

PANEL 3

Work as for Panel 1 substituting F for B and B for A.

PANEL 4

Work as for Panel 1 substituting E for B.

PANEL 5

Work as for Panel 1 substituting C for B and D for A.

FINISHING

Block each Panel to measure 10" [25.5 cm] wide x 59" [150 cm] long. Following photo, position Panels as shown.

Joining: With RS of 2 Panels facing each other, pin tog with T-pins, join matching leftover yarn with sl st through both thicknesses and work 1 row of sl st loosely to join Panels, taking care to match stripes.

Tassels (make 4 – 2 with F and 1 each with A and D)

Wind yarn around 5" [12.5 cm] piece of cardboard 25 times. Tie securely at one end. Cut across other end. Wrap yarn 5 times around tassel 1½" [4 cm] from tied end and fasten securely. Attach Tassels securely to each corner of Blanket.
