

## BERNAT® FAUX BRIOCHE KNIT COWL



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

### ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** = Approximately

**Beg** = Beginning

**Cont** = Continue

**K** = Knit

**K1below** = Knit into next stitch 1 row below, at same time slipping off stitch above.

**P** = Purl

**P1below** = Purl into next stitch 1 row below, at same time slipping off stitch above.

**Pat** = Pattern

**Rep** = Repeat

**Rnd(s)** = Round(s)

**RS** = Right side

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

**WS** = Wrong side



### INSTRUCTIONS

#### Notes:

- Worked over even number of sts.
- Leave yarn when not in use hanging loosely at WS of work.
- 2-Color Fisherman's Rib Pat forms reversible fabric where MC is dominant color on RS and A is dominant color on WS.

**1st rnd:** With MC, \*K1below. P1. Rep from \* around.

**2nd rnd:** With A, \*K1. P1below. Rep from \* around.

These 2 rnds form 2-color Fisherman's Rib Pat.

Cont in 2-Color Fisherman's Rib Pat until work from beg measures 9½" [24 cm], ending on a 1st rnd of pat.

**Next rnd:** With MC, knit.

**Next rnd:** Purl.

With MC, cast off loosely.

With MC, cast on 112 sts. Join in rnd, being careful not to twist sts, placing marker at first st.

**1st rnd:** Purl.

**2nd rnd:** Knit.

Proceed with 2-Color Fisherman's Rib pat as follows:

### MATERIALS

**Bernat® Softee® Chunky™** (3.5 oz/100 g; 108 yds/99 m)

**Main Color (MC)** Faded Denim (28114) **3 balls or 200 yds/183 m**

**Bernat® Softee® Chunky™ Twist™** (2.8 oz/80 g; 84 yds/77 m)

**Contrast A** Blue Shock (40003) **2 balls or 129 yds/118 m**

Size U.S. 11 (8 mm) circular knitting needle 36" [91.5 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch marker.

### MEASUREMENTS

Approx 10" [25.5 cm] deep x 50" [127 cm] around.

### GAUGE

9 sts and 18 rows = 4" [10 cm] in 2-Color Fisherman's Rib Pat.
