## SIZES

## To fit bust measurement Extra-Small/Extra-Large 28-46 ins [71-117 cm] <br> 2 Extra-Large/5 Extra-Large 48-62" [122-157.5"]

## GAUGE

17 sts and 32 rows $=4$ ins $[10 \mathrm{~cm}]$ in garter st.

## ABBREVIATIONS

Alt $=$ Alternate.
Beg $=$ Beginning.
Cont = Continue(ity).
$\mathbf{C h}=$ Chain.
Cont $=$ Continue.
Dec $=$ Decrease .
Inc 1 st in next st = Increase 1 stitch in next stitch.
$\mathbf{K}=$ Knit.
K2togtbl = Knit 2 stitches together through back loop.
$\mathbf{K} 2 \boldsymbol{t o g}=$ Knit 2 stitches together.
$\mathbf{P}=$ Purl.
Pat $=$ Pattern .
Psso = Pass slipped stitch over.
Rep $=$ Repeat .
Rem = Remaining.
RS = Right side.
Sc = Single Crochet
St(s) = Stitch(es).
Sl1 = Slip next stitch knitwise.
Sc $=$ Single crochet.
Tog = Together.
WS = Wrong side.

## MATERIALS

Bernat ${ }^{\circledR}$ Satin ( $100 \mathrm{~g} / 3.5 \mathrm{oz}$ )
Sizes XS/XL (2XL/5XL)
Main Color (MC) (Beige) 2-2 balls
Contrast A (Black) 3-4 balls
Contrast B (Burgundy) 3-3 balls
Size 5 mm (U.S. 8) knitting needles or size needed to obtain gauge. Size 5 mm (U.S. H or 8) crochet hook for neck edge.

## INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger size the instructions will be written thus ().

## Stripe Pat A

With MC, work 4 rows in garter st.
With A, work 4 rows in garter st.
With B, work 4 rows in garter st.
These 12 rows form Stripe Pat A.

## Stripe Pat B

With B, work 4 rows in garter st.
With A, work 4 rows in garter st.
With MC, work 4 rows in garter st.
These 12 rows form Stripe Pat B.

Square I (make 2)
**With MC, cast on 1 st.
1st row: (RS). (K1. P1. K1) all in st.
3 sts.
2nd and alt rows: Knit.
3rd row: Inc 1 st in first st. Inc 1 st in next st. K1. 5 sts.
5th row: With A, inc 1 st in first st. Knit to last 2 sts. Inc 1 st in next st. K1.
6th row: Knit.
Keeping cont of Stripe Pat A, inc 1 st each end of needle on next and every following alt row to 61 (73) sts.
Next row: (WS). With B, knit.
Next row: With MC, inc 1 st in first st. Knit to last 2 sts. Inc 1 st in next st. K1.
Next row: With MC, knit.**
***Next row: With MC, K1. K2tog. Knit to last 3 sts. Sl1. K1. psso. K1.
Next row: With MC, knit.

Proceed in Stripe Pat B, rep last 2 rows to 3 sts.
Next row: (RS). Sl1. K2tog. psso. Fasten off.***

Square II (make 4).
Work from ${ }^{* *}$ to ${ }^{* *}$ as given for Square I.
With A, work from ${ }^{* * *}$ to ${ }^{* * *}$ as given for Square I, omitting all references to color changing.

Square III (make 2).
Work from ** to ${ }^{* *}$ as given for Square I. With B, work from *** to ${ }^{* * *}$ as given for Square I, omitting all references to color changing.

Square IV (make 1)
With MC, cast on 1 st.
1st row: (RS). (K1. P1. K1) all in st. 3 sts.
2nd and alt rows: Knit.
3rd row: Inc 1 st in first st. Inc 1 st in next st. K1. 5 sts.

5th row: With A, inc 1 st in first st. Knit to last 2 sts. Inc 1 st in next st. K1.
7th row: As 5th row. 9 sts.

Shoulder shaping: 9th row: With B, inc 1 st in first st. K1. K2tog. K1. Place marker on last st. K2togtbl. Inc 1 st in next st. K1. 9 sts.
11th row: With B, as 5th row. 11 sts.
13th row: With MC, as 5th row. 13 sts.
15th row: With MC, inc 1 st in first st. Knit to 2 sts before marked st. K2tog. K1 (marked st). K2togtbl. Knit to last 2 sts. Inc 1 st in next st. K1. 13 sts.
17th and 19th rows: With $A$, as 5th row. 17 sts at end of last row.
21st row: With B, inc 1 st in first st. Knit to 2 sts before marked st. K2tog. K1 (marked st). K2togtbl. Knit to last 2 sts. Inc 1 st in next st. K1. 17 sts.
22nd row: Knit.
Keeping cont of Stripe Pat A, inc 1 st each end of needle on next and every following alt row, AT SAME TIME, dec 2 sts every following 6th row from previous dec, as before to 27 (33) sts.

Divide for neck opening: Next row: (WS). K12 (15). K2tog (neck edge). Turn. Leave rem sts on a spare needle. Next row: Sl1. K1. psso. Knit to last 2 sts. Inc 1 st in next st. K1.
Next row: Knit.
Rep last 2 rows 11 (12) times more.
Next row: (RS). With MC, Sl1. K1. psso. Knit to last 2 sts. Inc 1 st in next st. K1.
Next row: With MC, knit.
Next row: With MC, inc 1 st in first st. Knit to last 3 sts. Sl1. K1. psso. K1.
Next row: With MC, knit.
Proceed in Stripe Pat B, rep last 2 rows 11 (12) times more.
Break yarn. Leave rem sts on a st holder.
With WS of work facing, join yarn to sts on a spare needle and knit to end of row.
Next row: Inc 1 st in first st. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1 (neck edge).
Next row: Knit.
Rep last 2 rows 11 (12) times more.
Next row: With MC, inc 1 st in first st. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1.
Next row: Knit.
Next row: With MC, K1. Sl1. K1. psso. Knit to last 2 sts. Inc 1 st in next st. K1.
Next row: With MC, knit.
Proceed in Stripe Pat B, rep last 2 rows 11 (12) times more.

Joining row: (RS). K1. Sl1. K1. psso. Knit to end of row. Cast on 1 st. Place marker on last st. Knit sts from st holder to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1. 27 (33) sts.

## Next row: Knit.

Dec 1 st each end of needle on next and every following alt row, AT SAME TIME, inc 1 st at each side of marked st for shoulder shaping on 4th row from joining row and every following 6th row 4 times more to 3 sts.
Next row: (RS). Sl1. K2tog. psso. Fasten off.

Following Diagram, sew squares tog, using flat seam.
With crochet hook, join A with slip stitch to any corner at neck edge. Ch 1 . Work 64 sc around neck edge. Join with slip stitch to first sc. Fasten off.

Fringe: Cut A and B, 10 ins [ 25.5 cm ] long. Taking 1 strand each of A and B tog, knot into fringe across bottom edges of Poncho. Trim fringe evenly.
