 CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 56 x 62" [142 x 157.5 cm],
excluding tassels.

GAUGE

11 sts and 8 rows = 4" [10 cm] in pat.

Contrast A Dark Grey Mix (10618) **3 balls**

Contrast B Medium Grey Mix (10617) **1 ball**

Contrast C Soft Grey Mix (10616) **1 ball**

Contrast A Dark Grey Mix (10618) **3 balls**

Caron® Simply Soft® (6 oz/170.1g; 315 yds/288m)

Contrast B Taupe (9783) **1 ball**

Contrast C Chocolate (9750) **1 ball**

Contrast D Pumpkin (9765) **1 ball**

Contrast E Burgundy (9762) **1 ball**

Caron® Simply Soft® Collection (6 oz/170.1g; 315 yds/288m)

Contrast F Pistachio (0003) **1 ball**

Caron® One Pound™ (16 oz/453.6 g; 812 yds/742 m)

Contrast A Off White (10514) **3 balls**

Caron® Simply Soft® (6 oz/170.1g; 315 yds/288m)

Contrast B Fuchsia (9764) **1 ball**

Contrast C Orange (9778) **1 ball**

Contrast D Gold (9782) **1 ball**

Contrast E Chartreuse (9771) **1 ball**

Contrast F Cobalt Blue (9784) **1 ball**

Size U.S. I/9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**

INSTRUCTIONS

With A, ch 156.

1st row: (RS). 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 1 sc in each ch to end of chain. Turn. 155 sc.

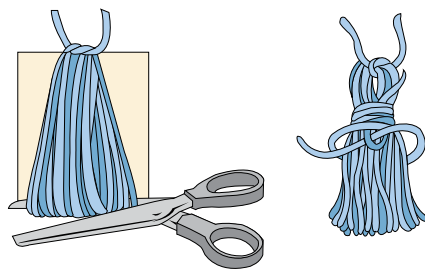
2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of next 5 sts. *1 dcbl in each of next 5 sts. 1 sc in each of next 5 sts. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

3rd row: Ch 3 (counts as dc). 1 dcbl in each of next 4 sts. *1 sc in each of next 5 sts. 1 dcbl in each of next 5 sts. Rep from * to end of row. Turn.

Rep last 2 rows for pat until work from beg measures 62" [157.5 cm], ending on a RS row. Fasten off.

Tassels (make 4 each with B, C, and D. Make 5 each with E and F)

Cut a piece of cardboard 6" [15 cm] wide. Wind yarn around cardboard 120 times. Break yarn leaving a long end and thread end through needle. Slip needle through all loops and tie tightly. Remove cardboard and wind yarn tightly around loops 1" [2.5 cm] below fold. Fasten securely. Cut through rem loops and trim ends evenly. Sew 11 Tassels to top and bottom of Throw, alternating colors as seen in picture.
