What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver
1 skein 311 White

- Foam or thick white cardboard (slightly larger than desired size of finished cloud)
- Tape
- Yarn needle
- Acrylic paint in red, yellow and blue
- Paper plate (for mixing paints)
- Paintbrush
- 6 clothespins

Wrapped Raincloud

Here's a perfect craft for a rainy day! Practice motor skills and name all the colors of the rainbow. If painting is too messy, use markers instead.

CLOUD Steps

1. Cut a cloud shape from foam or cardboard.
2. Without cutting yarn from skein, tape yarn to cloud shape and then gently wrap yarn around cloud. Cut yarn and tuck in the tail end.

RAINBOW Steps

Use paper plate as a pallet to mix red and blue for purple, red and yellow for orange and yellow and blue for green.



3. Paint each clothespin with one of the 6 colors.
4. Clip clothespins to cloud in rainbow color order.
