



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

SIZES

To fit chest measurement

6 mos	17"	[43 cm]
12 mos	18"	[45.5 cm]
18 mos	19"	[48 cm]
24 mos	20"	[51 cm]

Finished chest

6 mos	19"	[48 cm]
12 mos	20½"	[52 cm]
18 mos	22½"	[57 cm]
24 mos	24"	[61 cm]

GAUGE:

16 hdc and 13 rows= 4" [10 cm].

MATERIALS

Bernat® Baby Sport™ (12.3 oz/350 g; 1256 yds/1148 m)

Sizes	6	12	18	24	mos
Main Color (MC) Popsicle Blue (21730)	1	1	1	1	ball
Contrast A Blossom (21414)	1	1	1	1	ball
Contrast B Baby Taupe (21011)	1	1	1	1	ball

Size U.S. G/6 (4 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** 4 stitch markers. 3 buttons.

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (). When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes. For ease in working, circle all numbers pertaining to your size.

Note: Pullover is worked in one piece from neck edge down. Garment bodice section is worked in rows from neck edge to end of raglan shaping, then body rounds. Sleeves are worked in rounds with turns at the end of each round to maintain same pat as bodice section.

Note: Ch 2 at beg of row does not count as st.

Bodice Section: Beg at neck edge, with MC, ch **50 (52-56-58)**.

1st row: (RS). 1 hdc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 hdc in each of next **8 (9-10-10)** ch. 3 hdc in next ch and PM on center hdc. 1 hdc in each of next 6 ch. 3 hdc in next ch and PM on center hdc. 1 hdc in each of next **14 (14-16-18)** ch. 3 hdc in next ch and PM on center hdc. 1 hdc in each of next 6 hdc. 3 hdc in next ch and PM on

center hdc. 1 hdc in each of last **9 (10-11-11)** ch. Turn. **56 (58-62-64)** hdc.

2nd row: Ch 2. *1 hdc in each hdc to marked hdc. 3 hdc in marked hdc. Rep from * 3 times more. 1 hdc in each hdc to end of row. Turn. 8 hdc increased. **64 (66-70-72)** hdc.

Rep last row **7 (8-9-10)** times more. **120 (130-142-152)** hdc.

Divide for Body: Next row: Ch 2. 1 hdc in each of next **18 (20-22-23)** hdc. Ch 5. Skip next **26 (28-30-32)** hdc (Sleeve). 1 hdc in each of next **32 (34-38-42)** hdc. Ch 5. Skip next **26 (28-30-32)** hdc (Sleeve). 1 hdc in each of last **18 (20-22-23)** hdc. **78 (84-92-98)** sts for Body. Fasten off.

PM on Fronts in 2nd hdc from each end of last row. Overlap Right Front over Left Front at markers and pin in position.

Proceed in Body Pat as follows:

1st rnd: (RS). Join A with sl st in center ch of ch-5 of left armhole. Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as last sl st. 1 sc in each hdc or ch around, working through both thicknesses across 2 hdc at center front. Join with sl st to first sc. **76 (82-90-96)** sc.

2nd rnd: Beg puff st in first st. *Ch 1. Skip next st. Puff st in next st. Rep from * to last st. Ch 1. Skip last st. Join B with sl st in top of beg puff st.

3rd rnd: With B, ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as last sl st. *Working around ch-1 from previous rnd, 1 dc in next skipped st. 1 sc in next puff st. Rep from * to last st. Working around ch-1 from previous rnd, 1 dc in last skipped st. Join with sl st to first sc.

4th rnd: Ch 2. 1 hdc in each st around. Join MC with sl st to first hdc.

5th rnd: With MC, as 2nd rnd, joining A at end of rnd.

6th and 7th rnds: With A, as 3rd and 4th rnds, joining B at end of 7th rnd.

8th rnd: With B, as 2nd rnd, joining MC at end of rnd.

9th and 10th rnds: With MC, as 3rd and 4th rnds, joining A at end of 10th rnd.

11th rnd: With A, as 2nd rnd. Rep 3rd to 11th rnds for pat until Body from armhole joining rnd measures approx 6½ (7-9-10)" [16.5 (18-23-25.5) cm], ending on a 3rd, 6th or 9th rnd of pat. Fasten off.

SLEEVES

1st rnd: With RS (WS-RS-WS) facing, join MC with sl st in rem loop of center ch of ch-5 of armhole. Ch 2. 1 hdc in same sp as

last sl st. 1 hdc in each of next 2 ch. 1 hdc in each of next 26 (28-30-32) hdc. 1 hdc in each of last 2 ch. Join with sl st to first hdc. 31 (33-35-37) hdc. **Turn.**

2nd rnd: Ch 2. 1 hdc in each hdc around. Join with sl st to first hdc. **Turn.**

Rep last rnd 3 (4-4-5) times more.

Next rnd: Ch 2. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each hdc to last 2 hdc. Hdc2tog. Join with sl st to first st. **Turn.**

Next 4 (5-5-6) rnds: Ch 2. 1 hdc in each hdc around. Join with sl st to first hdc. **Turn.**

Next rnd: Ch 2. Hdc2tog. 1 hdc in each hdc to last 2 hdc. Hdc2tog. Join with sl st to first st. **Turn.** 27 (29-31-33) hdc.

Next rnd: Ch 2. 1 hdc in each hdc around. Join with sl st to first hdc. **Turn.** Rep last rnd until Sleeve from armhole joining rnd measures 6½ (7-8-9½)" [16.5 (18-20.5-24.5) cm]. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Left Front edging: 1st row: (RS). Join A with sl st at corner of neck edge at foundation ch. Ch 1. Work 17 (19-21-23) sc evenly down left front opening. **Turn.**

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc to end of row. Fasten off.

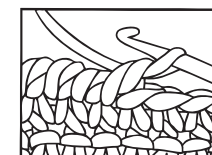
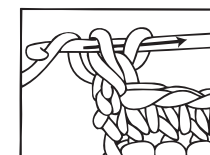
Right Front edging: 1st row: (RS). Join A with sl st at base of neck edge before Body. Ch 1. Work 17 (19-21-23) sc evenly up right front opening. **Turn.**

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. *Ch 3. Skip next 2 sc. 1 sc in each of next 4 (5-6-7) sc. Rep from * once more. Ch 3. Skip next 2 sc. 1 sc in each of last 2 sc. Fasten off.

Neck edging: 1st row: (RS). Join A with sl st at corner of right front neck edge at foundation ch. Ch 1. Work sc evenly across neck edge to opposite corner. **Do not turn.**

2nd row: Ch 1. Working from left to right, instead of from right to left, as usual, work 1 reverse sc in each sc to end of row. Fasten off.

Sew buttons in position to correspond to button loops.



ABBREVIATIONS:

Approx = Approximately
Beg = Beginning
Beg Puff st = Ch 2. (Yoh and draw up a loop) twice in next stitch. Yoh and draw through 4 loops on hook. Yoh and draw through rem 2 loops on hook.
Ch = Chain(s)
Dc = Double crochet
Hdc = Half double crochet

Hdc2tog = (Yoh and draw up a loop in next stitch) twice. Yoh and draw through all loops on hook.
Pat = Pattern
PM = Place marker
Puff st = (Yoh and draw up a loop) 3 times in next stitch. Yoh and draw through 6 loops on hook. Yoh and draw through rem 2 loops on hook.

Rem = Remaining
Rep = Repeat(s)
RS = Right side
Rnd(s) = Round(s)
Sc = Single crochet
Sl st = Slip stitch
Sp = Space
St(s) = Stitch(es)
WS = Wrong side
Yoh = Yarn over hook
