



Wavy Ripple Throw

Crochet a ripple throw with textural interest by using any of the colorful multi color shades of Super Saver. Choose coordinating solids for the perfect classic accent with a contemporary twist.

Throw measures 44" x 53".

RED HEART® "Super Saver®": 3 skeins 301 Mirage **A**, 2 skeins each 336 Warm Brown **B** and 334 Buff **C**, and 1 skein 661 Frosty Green **D**.

Crochet Hook: 5mm [US H-8].
Yarn needle.

GAUGE: 12 sts = 4", 7 rows = 3" in hdc. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATION

Cl (cluster) = [yo and draw up a loop around the post of the st 2 rows below, yo and draw through 2 loops] 3 times, yo and draw through all 4 loops on hook. Skip the st on the current row directly behind the Cl.

NOTE: Join and cut colors as required; where practicable carry color not in use up side of work.

THROW

Row 1 (Right Side): With **A**, ch 166; hdc in 2nd ch from hook, skip next ch, hdc in next 14 ch, [3 hdc in next ch, hdc in next 15 ch, skip next 2 ch, hdc in next 15 ch] 4 times, 3 hdc in next ch, hdc in next 14 ch, skip next ch, hdc in last ch; turn – 165 sts.

Row 2: Ch 2, skip first st, hdc in next 15 sts, [3 hdc in next st, hdc in next 15 sts, skip next 2 sts, hdc in next 15 sts] 4 times, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in next 14 sts, skip next st, hdc in last st; turn.

Row 3: Ch 2, skip first st, hdc in next 15 sts, [3 hdc in next st, hdc in next 15 sts, skip next 2 sts, hdc in next 15 sts] 4 times, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in next 14 sts, skip next 2 sts, hdc in top of ch-2; turn.

Rows 4-7: Repeat Row 3.

Rows 8-14: With **B**, repeat Row 3.

Rows 15 and 16: With **C**, repeat Row 3.

Row 17: With **D**, ch 2, skip first st, * hdc in next 2 sts, Cl, [hdc in next 4 sts, Cl] twice, hdc in next 2 sts, 3 hdc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts, Cl, [hdc in next 4 sts, Cl] twice **, hdc in next 2 sts, skip 2 sts; repeat from * to last 4 sts, end at **; hdc in next st, skip next 2 sts, hdc in top of ch-2; turn.

Row 18: Repeat Row 3.

Rows 19 and 20: With **C**, repeat Rows 17 and 18.

Rows 21 and 22: With **A**, repeat Rows 17 and 18.

Rows 23 and 24: Repeat Rows 19 and 20.

Rows 25-28: Repeat Rows 17-20.

Rows 29-35: With **B**, repeat Row 3.

Rows 36-42: With **A**, repeat Row 3.

Rows 43 and 44: With **C**, repeat Row 3.

Rows 45-48: Repeat Rows 17-20.

Rows 49 and 50: With **B**, repeat Rows 17 and 18.

Rows 51 and 52: With **C**, repeat Rows 17 and 18.

Rows 53-56: Repeat Rows 17-20.

Rows 57-63: With **A**, repeat Row 3.



Rows 64-98: Repeat Rows 8-42. At end of last row do not fasten off but turn to work Edging.

Edging

Ch 1, sc evenly around entire Throw taking care to keep work flat and working 3 sc in corner sts and points; join with a slip st in first sc. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS: **A, B, C, D** = color A, B, C, D; **ch** = chain; **hdc** = half double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch (es); **yo** = yarn over; *** or **** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated; **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
