What you will need:

RED HEART® Cordial™: 1 ball
9964 Greyscale

T or large head pins, 1½" [4 cm]
O ring

Macramé Plant Hanger

Beautifully designed with basic macramé knots, this plant hanger is perfect for any decorating style. This corded yarn is great for trying macramé!

Hanger measures 36" [91.5 cm] long, including bottom fringe

Will hold up to 9" [51 cm] diameter container

SPECIAL TERMS

double overhand knot = tie as for overhand knot, taking working end around and through center a second time.

knot-bearing cord = the cord around which knots are tied.

knitting cord = cord used to make knots.

sinnet = a chain of knots, usually vertical.

space = distance left open between last row of knots and next row to be tied.

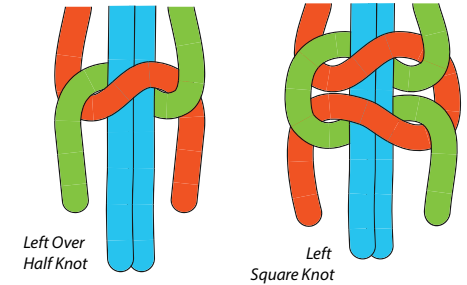
working end = the end of knitting cord being used to tie knots.

SPECIAL TECHNIQUES

Left Spiral Sinnet: tie specified number or length of Left Over Half Knots; allow chain to turn (cords switch position) naturally as sinnet lengths.

LSK Sinnet: tie specified number or length of Left Square Knots.

Alternating LSK: group 2 cords from knot to left in row or tier above with 2 cords from knot to right in row above. Knot-bearing cords from above become knitting cords, knitting cords become knot-bearing cords: tie LSK.

Notes

Work macramé pendants on pin board, heavy cardboard or other fixed point, using T or head pins to hold cords in place. Gridded board makes it easier to set spacing between knots.

For easier knotting, wrap ends of knitting cords into figure-eight bobbins or wrap around fingers and secure with elastic band. Let out cord as needed.

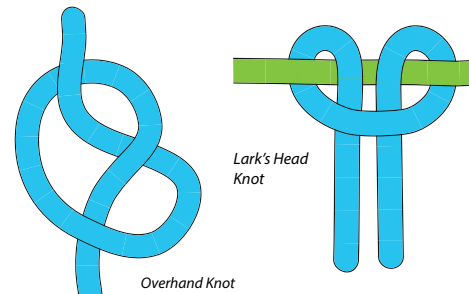
PLANT HANGER

Cut 4 cords 7 yds [6.5 m] and 4 cords 5 yds [4.5 m] long. Fold cords in half. Holding all cords together and using Lark's Head Knot, tie cords on O ring.

Separate into 4 groups of 4 cords, each group consisting of 2 short knot-bearing cords and 2 long knitting cords.

Tier 1: With each group, tie Left Spiral Sinnet 7" [18 cm] long (approx 12 twists, 48 half knots)—4 sinnets. Leave 3" (7.6 cm) space.

SHOP KIT

Tier 2: With each group, tie LSK Sinnet 7" [18 cm] long (approx 26 knots).
Leave 4" [10 cm] space.

Tier 3: Reforming groups and joining to work in the round, tie 2-knot sinnets of Alternating LSK.

Leave 3½" [9 cm] space.

Tier 4: Reforming groups and continuing in the round, tie 2-knot alternating LSK.

FINISHING

Leave 3½" [9 cm] space. Holding all cords together, tie double overhand knot. Measure down 6" [15 cm] from knot, cut ends. Tie double overhand knot 1" [2.5 cm] from bottom of each end; use fingers to fray end below knot.

ABBREVIATIONS

LSK = Left Square Knot; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
