- ¼ yard (.23m) Coats Eclectic Elements by Tim Holtz®, Ticking in Blue, PWTH006.BLUEX
- ¾ yard (68.6cm) Coats Eclectic Elements by Tim Holtz®, Dictionary in Neutral, PWTH008.NEUTR 19" x 19"
- Piece of Warm & Natural cotton batting  
WOF = Width of Fabric

## Cutting

### From Timepieces, PWTH003 cut:

(8) 5" x 5" (12.7cm x 12.7cm) squares. Cut each square once on the diagonal creating 16 half square triangles.

### From Stamps, PWTH007 and Ticking, PWTH006 cut:

(4) 5" x 5" (12.7cm x 12.7cm) squares. Cut each square once on the diagonal creating 8 half square triangles

### From Dictionary, PWTH008 cut:

(2) strips, 1 ½" (3.81cm) x WOF for borders

## Instructions

Note : Seam allowance is ¼" (.64cm) unless otherwise noted.

1. Make 8 blocks with half square triangles of the Timepieces PWTH003 and Stamps, PWTH007. Lay fabrics, right sides together and sew a ¼" (.64cm) seam on the diagonal edge. These are BLOCK A.
2. Repeat step 2 using Timepieces PWTH003 and Ticking, PWTH006. These are BLOCK B.
3. Refer to the quilt photo for the block layout.  
Row 1; A, B, B, A  
Row 2; B, A, A, B  
Row 3; B, A, A, B  
Row 4; A, B, B, A
4. Sew each row of blocks. Press seams in one direction.
5. Sew the four rows together. Press seams in one direction.
6. From your border strips, cut 2 strips, 1 ½" x 16 ½" (3.81cm x 41.9cm) for top and bottom borders and then cut 2 strips 1 ½" x 18 ½" (3.81cm x .47cm) for the sides of the quilt.
7. Sew the 1 ½" x 16 ½" (3.81cm x 41.9cm) strips to the top and the bottom of the quilt. Press.
8. Sew the 1 ½" x 18 ½" (3.81cm x .47cm) strips to the sides of the quilt. Press.
9. Cut remaining fabric Dictionary, PWTH008 to 22 ½" x 22 ½" (57.15cm x 57.15cm) for quilt backing. Lay the backing fabric with the right side to a flat surface. Layer with batting. Lay the wrong side of the quilt top on top of the batting. Quilt as desired.

10. Cut binding strips from remaining fabrics Ticking, PWTH006 and Stamps, PWTH007. Sew random lengths together - 2 ½" (6.35cm) wide - to equal 80" (2.03m) in length. Sew to quilt edges as French Fold Binding.
