Shivering Chic Shawl

Begin at the top center and crochet your way out to the points of a shawl that will turn heads. This is the cozy accessory you'll grab when you want to be ready for anything!

What you will need:

RED HEART® Chic Sheep by Marly Bird™: 1 ball each of 5311 Lace **A**, 5687 VIP **B**, 5635 Crème de Mint **C**, 5360 Suede **D**, 5620 Green Tea **E**, 5693 Poolside **F**

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook: 5mm [US H-8]

Yarn needle, stitch markers, 6" (15 cm) piece of cardboard

GAUGE: 12 dc = 4" (10 cm); 8 rows = 4" (10 cm) in stitch pattern. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

BUY YARN



RED HEART® Chic Sheep by Marly Bird™, Art. R170 100% Merino Wool available 3.5 oz (100 g), 186 yd (170 m) balls

Project measures 59" [150 cm] in wingspan, 29.5" [75 cm] in height.

Pattern Notes

Throughout pattern 3 dc in same st count as a dc group.

PATTERN

Make an adjustable loop with **A**.

Row 1 (WS): Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch-1 space throughout), (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc, ch 1, dc) in loop. Pull loop closed. Fasten off **A**. Turn. - 2 dc groups.

Row 2: Join **B** to first dc with slip st, ch 4, 3 dc in first ch-1 space, (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next ch-1 space (place marker in ch-1 space to mark center of shawl), 3 dc in tch-space, ch 1, dc in 3rd ch of tch. Fasten off **B**. Turn - 4 dc groups.

Row 3: Join **C** to first dc with slip st, ch 4, 3 dc in first ch-1 sp, 3 dc in space between next dc group, (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in next ch-1 space (move marker to ch-1 space), 3 dc in space between next dc group, 3 dc in tch-space, ch 1, dc in 3rd ch of tch. Fasten off **C**. Turn - 6 dc groups.

Row 4: Join **D** to first dc with slip st, ch 4, 3 dc in first ch-1 space, 3 dc in space between next dc group across to marker, (3 dc, ch 1, 3 dc) in marked ch-1 space (move marker to ch-1 space), 3 dc in space between next dc group across to tch, 3 dc in tch-space, ch 1, dc in 3rd ch of tch. Fasten off **D**. Turn - 8 dc groups.

Rows 5-42: Repeat Row 4 changing colors in following order: **E, F, A, B, C, D**. Fasten off- 84 dc groups.

FINISHING

Weave in all loose ends

Tassels

Cut 2 pieces of **F** yarn, 12" (30 cm) each, put aside. Wrap yarn around 6" (15 cm) piece of cardboard 65 times, cut on one side creating 1 bundle of 65 strands. Place bundle evenly between one 12" (30 cm) piece of yarn, tie bundle into place (assure strands are even). Fold bundle so that strands are even, tie second 12" (30 cm) piece of yarn around bundle, 1" (2.5 cm) below knot. Trim bundle ends to make even. Make 2 more tassels in similar manner. Sew tassels to corners of shawl.


ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; **ch-space** = chain space; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **sl st** = slip stitch; **dc** = double crochet; **tch** = turning chain; **RS** = right side; **WS** = wrong side; **()** = work directions in parentheses in same st; **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
