



SHOP KIT



1. Measure your can and place your adhesive on the can. If you are using glue you will want to add the glue only to the section you are working on.
2. Cut about 24 inches of each color of yarn. Tie a knot in one end and tightly braid the three strands together. Tie a knot when finished. Repeat two more times for a total of three braids. Set aside.
3. With first color, start wrapping around the can for about an inch. Take one strand of the braided yarn and wrap this around twice, tie off in a knot and trim ends. Repeat two more times until you have reached the bottom of the can.
4. Put adhesive on the top rim of the can and with yarn; tie ends in a bow. Add yarn around bottom of the can.

FINISHING

Line the inside of the can with construction paper or some type of fabric if you wish.
