## What you will need:

Aunt Lydia's® Classic Crochet Thread, Size 10: 1 ball 494 Victory Red

Susan Bates® Steel Crochet Hook: 1.5mm [US 7 steel]

Tapestry needle, earring wires, small amount of fiberfill stuffing

**GAUGE:** 2 sc = ¼" (6.4 mm).  
**CHECK YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook to obtain the gauge.

AUNT LYDIA'S® Classic Crochet Thread, Size 10, Art. 154 available in white & ecru 400 yd; solid color 250 yd; shaded color 300 yd balls



# Be Still My Heart Earrings

*These heart-shaped earrings are crocheted with crochet thread in little time. They are perfect for any occasion, but especially nice to give as a Valentine's Day gift!*

Earring measures 1" (2½ cm) x 1¼" (3 1/8 cm)

## EARRINGS (Make 2)

### Heart (Make 2)

### Side (Make 2)

**Row 1 (Right Side):** Ch 2, 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook; ch 1, turn – 3 sc.

**Row 2:** 2 sc first sc, sc in next sc, 2 sc in last sc; ch 1, turn – 5 sc.

**Row 3:** 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc across to last 2 sc, 2 sc in last sc; ch 1, turn – 7 sc.

**Rows 4–6:** Repeat Row 3 – 13 sc.

**Row 7:** Sc in each sc across; ch 1, turn – 13 sc.

**Row 8:** Sc in first sc, hdc in next sc, dc in next sc, tr in next sc, dc in next sc, hdc in next sc, sl st in next sc, hdc in next sc, dc in next sc, tr in next sc, dc in next sc, hdc in next sc, sc in last sc; ch 1, turn – 13 sc.

**Row 9:** Repeat Row 8.

### First Side

Fasten off and weave in ends.

### Second Side

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

## FINISHING

Using long piece, sew 2 Sides Wrong Sides together beginning to halfway point, stuffing with fiberfill as you sew. Finish sewing remainder of edge. Fasten off and weave in ends. Sew earring wire to assembled earring.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**ch** = chain; **cm** = centimeter; **dc** = double crochet; **hdc** = half double crochet; **mm** = millimeters; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **tr** = treble crochet; **[ ]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; **\*** or **\*\*** = repeat whatever follows the \* or \*\* as indicated.
