

RED HEART THAT'S THE POINT CHEVRON CROCHET BLANKET



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

Ch = Chain(s)

Dec = Decrease(ing)

Pat = Pattern

Rep = Repeat

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

Sc2tog = Draw up a loop in each of next 2 stitches. Yoh and draw through all loop on hook.

Sl st = Slip stitch

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tog = Together

WS = Wrong side

Yoh = Yarn over hook

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 47¼" x 57" [120 x 144.5 cm], excluding fringe.

GAUGE

11 sc and 13 rows = 4" [10 cm].

Panel = 5¼" [13 cm] wide by x 56" [142 cm] long.

INSTRUCTIONS

Notes:

- Blanket is worked in 9 Panels and seamed tog in finishing.
- Panels are worked from top down.

Panel (make 9 alike)

Ch 2. See diagram on page 2.

1st row: (RS). 3 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 1. 2 sc in first sc. 3 sc in next sc. 2 sc in last sc. Turn. 7 sts.

3rd row: Ch 1. 2 sc in first sc. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. 3 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. 2 sc in last sc. Turn. 11 sts.

4th row: Ch 1. 2 sc in first sc. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc. 3 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc. 2 sc in last sc. Turn. 15 sts.

5th row: Ch 1. 2 sc in first sc. 1 sc in each of next 6 sc. 3 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of next 6 sc. 2 sc in last sc. Turn. 19 sts.

6th row: Ch 1. 1 sc in each of first 9 sc. 3 sc in next sc. 1 sc in each of last 9 sc. Turn. 21 sts.

Proceed in Chevron Pat as follows:

MATERIALS

Red Heart® Gemstone™ (7 oz/200 g; 312 yds/285 m)

Peridot (2173)

8 balls

Size U.S. K/10½ (6.5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch marker.

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1st row: (RS). Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. Skip next sc. 1 sc in each of next 8 sc. 3 sc in next sc- 3-sc cluster made. 1 sc in each of next 8 sc. Skip next sc. 1 sc in last sc. Turn. 21 sc. Rep last row until work from beg measures 56" [142 cm], ending on a WS row and placing marker in first sc of 3-sc cluster of final row.

Dec First Corner

1st row: (RS). Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. Skip next sc. 1 sc in each of next 6 sc. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next sc. Turn. 8 sc.

****2nd row:** Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. Skip next sc. 1 sc in each of next 4 sc. Skip next sc. 1 sc in last sc. Turn. 6 sc.

3rd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in first sc. Skip next sc. 1 sc in each of next 2 sc. Skip next sc. 1 sc in last sc. Turn. 4 sc.

4th row: Ch 1. (Sc2tog) twice. Turn. 2 sts.

5th row: Ch 1. Sc2tog.** Fasten off.

Dec Second Corner

1st row: (RS). Join yarn with sl st in top of marked sc. Ch 1. 1 sc in same sc as last sl st. Skip next sc. 1 sc in each of next 6 sc. Skip next sc. 1 sc in next sc. Turn. 8 sc.

Rep from ** to ** of Dec First Corner. Fasten off.

FINISHING

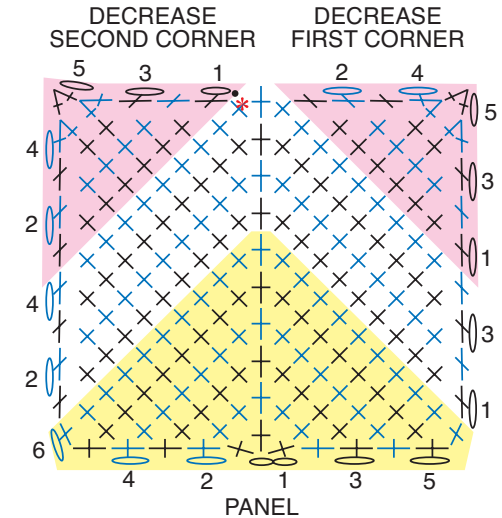
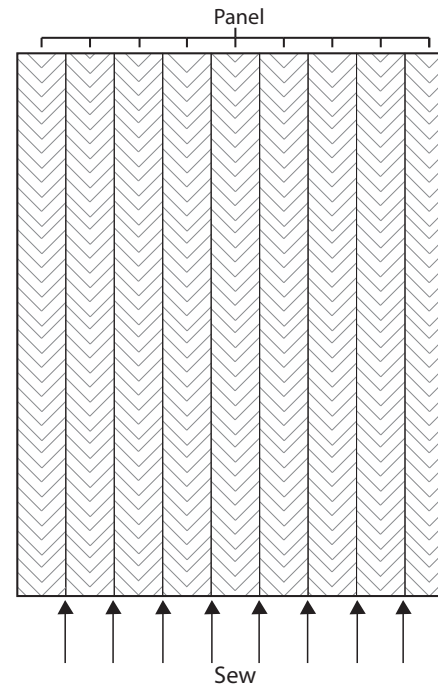
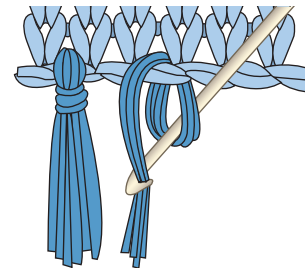
Pin Panels to measurements. Cover with a damp cloth to dry. Sew Panels tog as shown in diagram, noting self-striping color changes will **not** line up across Panels but chevrons should all be pointing in same direction.

Top Edging: 1st row: (RS). Join yarn with sl st to top right corner. Ch 1. Work sc evenly across top edge of Blanket. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 1. Work 1 sc in each sc across. Fasten off.

Bottom Edging: Work as for Top Edging across bottom edge of Blanket.

Fringe: Cut strands of yarn 12" [30.5 cm] long. Taking 3 strands tog, fold in half and knot into fringe through every other st along top and bottom edges. Trim fringe evenly.
