## What you will need:

RED HEART® Vivid™: 1 ball each  
6761 Powerful Pink A, 6631  
Glowing Green B, 6224 Laser  
Yellow C


Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:  
16mm [US Q] or size needed to  
obtain gauge.

Yarn needle.

**GAUGE:** 1 shell and 1 sc in pattern  
and 3 rounds = 4" (10 cm). **CHECK  
YOUR GAUGE.** Use any size hook  
to obtain the gauge.

# Shell Power Beanie

*Have fun crocheting this hat in bright bulky  
yarn in simple shell stitches. Cool hat to make  
and wear or give to your friends!*

Finished Size: 20" (50.8 cm) in  
circumference; 10" (25 cm) tall

## Special Stitch

Shell: 3 dc in indicated st.

## Notes

Ch-3 at beginning of rounds counts as dc  
unless otherwise stated.

Do not turn at end of rounds unless otherwise  
stated.

Join rounds with slip st in indicated st or  
space unless otherwise stated.

## BEANIE

With A, ch 4, join with slip st in first ch to form  
ring.

**Round 1 (Right side):** Ch 3, 9 dc in ring, join  
with a slip st in top of beginning ch-3, fasten  
off—10 dc.

**Round 2:** With right side facing, join B with sc  
in any st, shell in next st, \*sc in next st, shell  
in next st; repeat from \* 3 more times, join  
with slip st in beginning sc, fasten off—5 sc,  
5 shells.

**Round 3:** With right side facing, join C with  
sc in center st of any shell, shell in next sc,  
\*sc in center st of next shell, shell in next sc;  
repeat from \* 3 more times, fasten off—5 sc,  
5 shells.

**Round 4:** With right side facing, using A,  
repeat round 3.

**Round 5:** With right side facing, using B,  
repeat round 3.

**Rounds 6–7:** Repeat rounds 3–4. Do not  
fasten off at end of last round.

**Round 8:** Ch 1, sc in each st around, join with  
slip st in beginning sc, fasten off—20 sc.

## FINISHING

With yarn needle, weave in ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain; dc = double crochet; sc = single  
crochet; sp(s) space(es); st(s) = stitch(es); ( )  
= work directions in parentheses into same st;  
\* = repeat whatever follows the \* as indicated.
