



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: EASY

## ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** = Approximately

**K** = Knit

**P** = Purl

**Pat** = Pattern

**Rep** = Repeat

**RS** = Right side

**St(s)** = Stitch(es)

## MEASUREMENT

Approx 37½" [95 cm] square.

## GAUGE

17 sts and 24 rows = 4" [10 cm] in pat.

## INSTRUCTIONS

### STRIPS 1 and 4

With A, cast on 33 sts.

**1st row:** (RS). Knit.

**2nd row:** P1. \*K1. P1. Rep from \* to end of row.

Rep last 2 rows for pat 22 times more. 46 rows in total.

With B, rep last 2 rows 23 times more.

With C, rep last 2 rows 23 times more.

With A, rep last 2 rows 23 times more.

With B, rep last 2 rows 23 times more.

Cast off.

### STRIPS 2 and 5

Work in pat as given for Strip 1 in the following sequence: B, C, A, B, C.

### STRIP 3

Work in pat as given for Strip 1 in the following sequence: C, A, B, C, A.

### FINISHING

Arrange Strips 1 to 5 with cast-on edges at lower edge and sew together.

## MATERIALS

**RED HEART® Super Saver®** (7 oz/198 g; 364 yds/333 m)

**Contrast A** Aran (0313) **2 balls**

**Contrast B** Country Blue (0382) **2 balls**

**Contrast C** Windsor Blue (0380) **2 balls**

Size U.S. 8 (5 mm) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.**  
Tapestry needle.
