What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®:
1 skein each 672 Spring Green **A**, 324 Bright Yellow **B**, 718 Shocking Pink **C**, 520 Minty **D**, 319 Cherry Red **E**, 316 Soft White **F**, and 886 Blue **G**

Tape measure; 36" (91.5 cm) long wooden dowel; 2 removable Command™ hooks; 1 nail; hammer; scissors; cardboard; hot glue gun; Susan Bates® Easy Wrap Pom-Pom Maker; 18 decorative hangers for pompoms; 18 push pins; Recollections™ Circle, Scallop Circle, and Hexagon Lever Punches (optional); multi-colored cardstock (optional); low tack tape (optional)

Yarn Pom Pom Wall Tree

If you don't have space for a traditional tree, don't worry. Create this Christmas tree in no time, with pompoms and an easy-to-wrap star!

Tree measures 36" (91.5 cm) wide and 60" (152.5 cm) tall.

TREE

1. Measure 3½" (9 cm) from the top of the baseboard. Place removable hooks on the wall, spacing hooks about 18" (46 cm) apart.
2. Place dowel on removable hooks.



3. Find the center of the dowel and measure 60" (152.5) from the center dowel up the wall. Hammer a nail there, leaving ½" (1.25 cm) of the nail head exposed from the wall.



4. With **A**, tie a double knot around the nail.



5. Pulling from the outside, draw a continuous piece of yarn from the nail down to the dowel. Wrap the yarn around the dowel from front to back, then around the nail at the top.
6. Repeat step 5 until you have wrapped the yarn around the dowel and the nail 7 times, evenly spacing the yarn and wrapping the 4th strand down the center.

7. Cut and tie off the yarn around the nail. Remove the hooks and allow the dowel to hang freely



STAR

1. Create a star template out of cardboard measuring about 4" (10 cm) tall.
2. With **B**, hold the yarn tail in the middle of the star.



3. Wrap yarn around each point of the star evenly, and then back around the center using one continuous piece of yarn. If the yarn on the tips of the star begin to fall off, place a dot of hot glue on each point to secure them.



4. Once the entire star has been covered evenly and no cardboard is showing, cut the yarn and attach it to the back of the star by tying in place.
5. Place a dot of hot glue on the head of the nail at the top of the tree. Press the star firmly in place on top of the nail, centering the star on the nail.



POMPOM ORNAMENTS

1. Following manufacturer's instructions, make 18 pompoms varying in size and color using **C, D, E, F,** and **G**, leaving two long yarn tails for attaching the pompoms to the hangers.



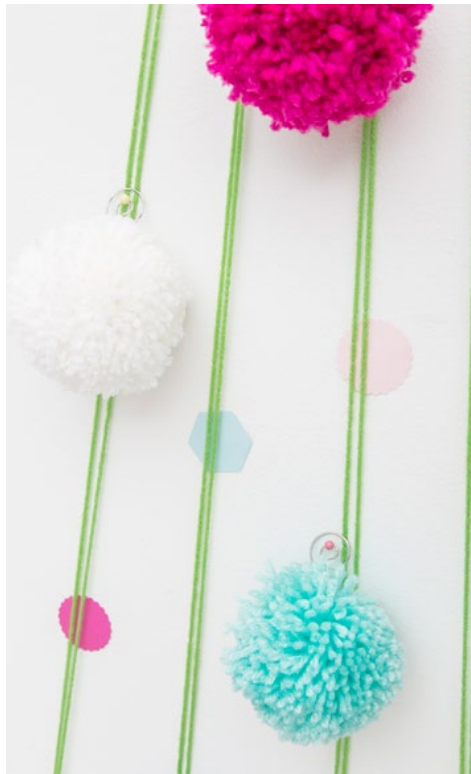

2. Tie each pompom to a decorative hanger. Secure to the wall with push pins.
3. Trim the longer strands of yarn so that they are even with the rest of the pompom.



PAPER DECORATIONS (optional)

1. Using the multi-colored cardstock and craft punches, punch varying shapes and sizes of paper decorations. Attach to the wall using low tack tape.
