What you will need:

RED HEART® Fur™: 1 ball each:
9631 Pine **A**, 9319 Cherry **B**,
9101 Snow **C**

- **Susan Bates® Easy-Wrap Pom-pom Maker**
- Foam Cone base - 1 each 6, 9 and 12" [15, 23 and 30.5 cm]
- 3 black buttons (1 each, small, medium and large) - optional
- Corsage Pins
- Scissors

Christmas Tree Trio

These trees will brighten up any dreary corners of your home. This easy craft is a perfect snow-day activity.

CHRISTMAS TREES

With **C**, make 3 pompoms, Small 1" (3cm), Medium 1.75" (4.5 cm), Large 2" (5cm)

SMALL TREE

Steps (refer to photos):

1. Using 6" [15 cm] cone, and without cutting yarn from ball, pin **A** to the bottom edge of the cone.



2. Wrap yarn around the cone to about 1/3 of its height. Cut yarn, pin in place.



3. Without cutting yarn from ball, pin **B** to the cone along the top wrapped edge of **A**.



4. Wrap yarn around the cone to about 2/3 of its height. Cut yarn, pin in place.

5. Without cutting yarn from ball, pin **C** yarn to the cone along the top wrapped edge of **B**.



6. Wrap yarn around the cone to top. Cut yarn, pin in place.



7. Pin small pom-pom to top of cone.



8. Pin small button to center of **B** section (optional).



MEDIUM AND LARGE CHRISTMAS TREES

Repeat steps 1-8 for each cone, using medium pom-pom and button for medium tree and large pom-pom and button for large tree.
