What you will need:

RED HEART® Strata™: 2 balls
2013 Aran

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
9mm [US M-13]

Yarn needle

GAUGE: 4 V-sts = 4" (10 cm); 6
rows = 4" (10 cm). Exact gauge is
not critical for this project.



RED HEART® Strata™,
Art E850 available in
3.5 oz (100 g) 95 yd
(86 m) balls



**Cowl measures 7½" long x 35"
circumference (19 x 89 cm).**

Special Stitch

V-st (V-stitch) = 2 dc in indicated stitch or
space.

Note

When instructed to work into a V-stitch,
work in the space between double crochet
stitches.

COWL

Ch 16.

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook (beginning
ch count as first dc), *skip next ch, V-st in
next ch; repeat from * across, turn—7 V-sts.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and
throughout), dc in first V-st (beginning
ch 3, dc count as first V-st), V-st in each
remaining V-st, turn.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 35"
(91.5 cm) or desired length.

Joining Row: Holding first and last rows
together and working through both
thicknesses, ch 1, slip st in each st across.
Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain(s); **dc** = double crochet; **st(s)** =
stitch(es); * = repeat whatever follows the *
as indicated.



Very V-Stitch Cowl

*If you know how to chain and how to do a double
crochet, then you can do a V-stitch. It's perfect for
a quick drape-y cowl in this tubular jersey yarn.
You'll love how nice it feels!*

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
