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## BERNAT KNIT DIPPED PULLOVER



#### MATERIALS

<b>Bernat<sup>®</sup> Baby Velvet™</b> (10.5 oz/300 g; 492 yds/450 m)					
Sizes	6 mos	12 mos	18 mos	24 mos	
Contrast A Peach Blossom (86037)	1	1	1	1	ball
Contrast B Yolk Yellow (86041)	1	1	1	1	ball

Sizes U.S. 6 (4 mm) and U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) circular knitting needles 16" [41 cm] and 24" [40 cm] long. Set of 4 sizes U.S. 6 (4 mm) and U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) double-pointed needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch marker.

#### ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximate(ly)
Beg = Beginning
Cont = Continue
K = Knit
K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches
together
M1 = Make 1 stitch by picking up
horizontal loop lying before next
stitch and knit into back of loop.
P = Purl
Pat = Pattern

# PM = Place marker Rep = Repeat Rnd(s) = Round(s) RS = Right side Ssk = Slip next 2 stitches knitwise one at a time. Pass them back onto left-hand needle, then knit through back loops together St(s) = Stitch(es) WS = Wrong side

#### SIZES

To fit chest measurement 6 mos 17" [43 cm] 18" [45.5 cm] **12 mos** 18 mos 19" [48.5 cm] 24 mos 20" [51 cm] **Finished chest** 21" [53.5 cm] 6 mos 12 mos 22" [56 cm] 24" [61 cm] 18 mos 26" [66 cm] 24 mos

#### GAUGE

16 sts and 20 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st with larger needle

#### **INSTRUCTIONS**

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger size(s) the instructions will be written thus (). When only one number is given, it applies to all sizes.

**Note:** Sweater is worked from neck edge down.

With smaller, shorter circular needle and A, cast on **52** (60-64-68) sts. Join in rnd. PM for beg of rnd.

**1st to 5th rnds:** \*K1. P1. Rep **SLE** from \* around. With

#### SLEEVES

Change to larger, shorter circular needle and proceed as follows, switching to longer needle when necessary:

**1st rnd:** \*K**20** (**22-24-26**). PM. K**6** (**8-8-8**). PM. Rep from \* once more. **2nd rnd:** \*K1. M1. Knit until 1 st before next marker. M1. K1. Slip marker. Rep from \* to end of rnd. **60** (**68-72-76**) sts.

3rd rnd: Knit.

Rep last 2 rnds **9** (**9-10-11**) times more. **132** (**140-152-164**) sts.

**Divide for Sleeves: Next rnd:** \*Knit to next marker. Slip next **26** (28-30-32) sts onto scrap yarn for Sleeve. Cast on 2 sts. Rep from \* once more. **84** (88-96-104) sts.

#### BODY

With B, knit even in rnds until work from dividing rnd measures 6½ (7-7½-8)" [16.5 (18-19-20.5) cm] from armhole divide. Change to smaller, longer circular needle. Next 4 rnds: \*K1. P1. Rep from \* around. Cast off loosely in pat. With B and larger set of doublepointed needles, join yarn to right sleeve sts. K26 (28-30-32). Pick up and knit 2 sts at underarm. PM in between 2 picked up sts for beg of rnd. Divide sts onto 3 needles. Join in rnd. PM on first st. 28 (30-32-34) sts.

Knit 16 (12-13-15) rnds even.

Next rnd: K2tog. Knit to last 2 sts. ssk. 26 (28-30-32) sts. Knit 7 (7-7-5) rnds even. Rep last 8 (8-8-6) rnds 1 (2-2-3) time(s) more. 24 (24-26-26) sts.

Change to smaller set of doublepointed needles. **Next 5 rnds:** \*K1. P1. Rep from \* around. Cast off loosely in pat. Break A.

#### FINISHING

Sew sleeves at underarms.
