

Bracelets measures $51 / 2$ " [14 cm] excluding ties

SPECIAL TERMS
knot-bearing cord = the cord(s) around which
knots are made.
knotting cord = cord used to make knots

## SPECIAL TECHNIQUES



Overhand knot = small knot used to bring strands together


Slip knot = adjustable knot in which one strand can slide up and down the other


Left Over Half Hitch = tie Left Over Half Hitch once


Left Over Double Half Hitch = tie Left Over Half Hitch twice

## BRACELET

## Prepare cords

Cut one 36 " $[91.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] length in each color.
Holding ends together and leaving a 6 " 15 cm ] tail, make a slip knot. Secure slip knot to fixed point.

Arrange single strands of cord in following order:
A, B, C, D, E

## Knot cords

*Beginning at left edge with A and holding remaining cords together as one knot-bearing cord, tie Left Over Double Half Hitch. Repeat from * until section measures $3 / 4$ " [2 cm].
*With B as knotting cord and holding A with other colors as knot-bearing cord, tie Left Over Double Half Hitch. Repeat from * until section measures $3 / 4 "$ [2 cm]
*With $\mathbf{C}$ as knotting cord and holding $\mathbf{B}$ with other colors as knot-bearing cord, tie Left Over Double Half Hitch. Repeat from * until section measures $3 / 4$ " [2 cm].

Continue as above, changing knotting cord to next color in sequence every $3 / 4$ " until bracelet measures $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " [14 cm] from loop or to desired length, leaving 6 " $[15 \mathrm{~cm}$ ] tail. Tie overhand knot to secure.

## FINISHING

Braid 6" 15 cm ] tails at each end and tie overhand knot to secure. Trim ends to same length.

Tie braided ends together with overhand knot or in a bow to secure.
