Featuring Coats & Clark Dual Duty XP® Thread

The mermaid is looking out into the vast ocean for her family of sea life. Perfect for beach themed décor or the bedroom of a little girl who loves mermaids. Create the scene with applique and surface stitching to add details.

Supplies

- Coats & Clark Dual Duty XP® All Purpose Thread in colors to match fabrics
- Coats & Clark Dual Duty XP® Heavy Thread
- 1 yard Blue fabric for ocean
- ½ yard Brown fabric for sand
- ¼ yard fabric for binding
- ¼ yd or scraps of fabrics for the seaweed, shells, hair, flowers, skin and turtles
- 1 yd backing fabric
- 2½ yds paper backed fusible web such as Wonder Under
- (1) 30" x 26" rectangle of batting
- Topstitching machine needle
- Marking pen or pencil
- Yard Stick
- Scissors
- Pattern Pieces for Mermaid on page 3-5 and other details

Cutting

From Blue fabric cut 1 rectangle 30" x 26" for front Cut 1 30" x 26" rectangle for backing Cut 1 30" x 26" rectangle from batting 3 strips, 2½" x width of fabric for binding

Preparing Pattern Pieces


- Print and cut out paper patterns on pages 3-8 or 9.
 Note: Double check printing instructions on each template page. Choose page 8 or 9 for the coral.
 Trace each piece on paper side of the fusible web.
 Rough cut around each piece.
- 2. Following manufacturer's instructions, fuse each pattern piece to the wrong side of appropriate fabric. Cut out on cutting lines.
- 3. Place the blue front rectangle on a flat surface. Lay out the cut pattern pieces using the photo as a guide.
- 4. One at a time peel paper backing off fusible web, larger pieces first, and fuse in place.


Applique

- Use marking pencil to draw lines down seaweed and lines through the mermaid's hair. Thread machine with Coats & Clark Dual Duty XP® Heavy Thread. Insert a topstitching needle in the sewing machine. Straight stitch with the center of the seaweed. Straight stitch lines on the mermaid's hair. Stitch down between the mermaid's arms.
- Use marking pen to draw lips and eye. Hand stitch using Coats & Clark Dual Duty XP® Heavy Thread.
- Place backing fabric on flat surface, wrong side up. Place batting over backing fabric. Cover with appliqued front, right side facing up. pin edges.
- 4. Make 8 flowers for hair garland. For each flower cut 2 circles ½" diameter. Place circles wrong sides together. Pinch the center to gather flower and sew a couple of hand stitches to hold in place. Loosely sew the flowers together to form a garland. Hand sew to the mermaid's hair.


Finishing


- Sew the binding strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Press the seams open, then press the binding in half wrong sides together.
- 2. Bind the guilt edges, mitering the corners.
- Turn the binding to the quilt underside and handstitch the fold to the quilt backing.


