Bernat® Satin™ (3.5 oz/100 g; 200 yds/182 m)

Sizes	XS/S	M	L	XL	2/3XL	4/5XL	
Sable (04011)	5	5	6	6	7	8	balls

Sizes U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) and U.S. 8 (5 mm) knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge**. 5 st holders.

Finished bust

X-Small/Small 38" [96.5 cm]

2/3 X-Large 60" [152.5 cm]
4/5 X-Large 68" [173 cm]

GAUGE

18 sts and 24 rows = 4" [10 cm] with larger needles in stocking st.

INSTRUCTIONS

The instructions are written for smallest size. If changes are necessary for larger sizes the instructions will be written thus (.).

BACK

With smaller needles, cast on **86 (95-104-113-135-153) sts.
 Knit 7 rows (garter st), noting first row is WS and inc **4 (5-6-7-7-9)** sts evenly across last row. **90 (100-110-120-142-162)** sts.

Change to larger needles and proceed in stocking st until work from beg measures **13½ (14½-15-15-16-16)" [34.5 (37-38-38-40.5-40.5) cm]**, ending with a WS row.

Shape raglans: Cast off **5 (5-5-7-8-8)** sts beg next 2 rows. **80 (90-100-106-126-146)** sts.**

Work 2 rows even.

Next row: (RS). K1. ssk. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1.

Work 3 rows even.

Rep last 4 rows **7 (5-3-2-0-0)** times more. **64 (78-92-100-124-144)** sts.

Next row: (RS). K1. ssk. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1.

Next row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows **0 (6-12-15-11-0)** times more. **62 (64-66-68-100-142)** sts.

Proceed as follows:

1st row: (RS). K1. ssk. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1.

2nd row: P1. P2tog. Purl to last 3 sts. P2togtbl. P1.

3rd row: As 1st row.

4th row: Purl.

Rep last 4 rows **3 (3-3-3-8-15)** times more, then 1st and 2nd rows once. Leave rem **34 (36-38-40-42-42)** sts on a st holder.

FRONT

Work from ** to ** as given for Back.

Divide for front opening: Next row: (RS). **K40** (45-50-53-63-73) sts. **Turn.**

Leave rem sts unworked.

Next row: Purl.

Next row: K1. ssk. Knit to end of row.

Work 3 rows even.

Rep last 4 rows **7** (5-3-2-0-0) times more.

32 (39-46-50-62-72) sts.

Sizes M, L, XL, 2/3XL and 4/5XL only:

Next row: (RS). K1. ssk. Knit to end of row.

Next row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows (5-11-14-11-0) times more. (33-34-35-50-71) sts.

Sizes 2/3XL and 4/5XL only:

1st row: (RS). K1. ssk. Knit to end of row.

2nd row: Purl to last 3 sts. P2togtbl. P1.

3rd row: As 1st row.

4th row: Purl.

Rep last 4 rows (2-9) times more, then 1st and 2nd rows once. 39 sts.

All sizes: Shape neck: 1st row: (RS). K1. ssk. **K21** (21-21-21-26-26) sts. **Turn.** Leave rem **8** (9-10-11-10-10) sts on a st holder.

2nd row: Purl.

3rd row: K1. ssk. Knit to last 2 sts. K2tog.

4th row: P2tog. Purl to last 3 sts. P2togtbl. P1.

5th row: As 3rd row.

6th row: P2tog. Purl to end of row.

7th row: As 3rd row.

Sizes XS/S, M, L and XL only:

8th row: Purl to last 3 sts. P2togtbl. P1.

9th row: As 3rd row.

10th row: Purl.

11th row: As 3rd row.

12th row: As 8th row.

13th row: K1. ssk. Knit to end of row.

14th row: Purl.

15th row: As 13th row.

Rep last 4 rows once more. 3 sts.

Next row: (WS). P1. P2togtbl. 2 sts.

Next row: ssk. Fasten off.

Sizes 2/3XL and 4/5XL only:

8th row: As 4th row.

9th row: As 3rd row.

10th row: Purl.

11th row: As 3rd row.

12th row: Purl to last 3 sts. P2togtbl. P1.

13th row: As 3rd row.

14th row: Purl.

15th row: K1. ssk. Knit to end of row.

16th row: As 12th row.

17th row: As 15th row.

Rep 14th to 17th rows once more. 4 sts.

Next row: (WS). P4.

Next row: ssk. K2.

Next row: P1. P2togtbl.

Next row: ssk. Fasten off.

All sizes: With RS of work facing, join yarn to rem sts. Knit to end of row.

Next row: Purl.

Next row: Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1.

Work 3 rows even.

Rep last 4 rows **7** (5-3-2-0-0) times more.

32 (39-46-50-62-72) sts.

Sizes M, L, XL, 2/3XL and 4/5XL only:

Next row: (RS). Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1.

Next row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows (5-11-14-11-0) times more. (33-34-35-50-71) sts.

Sizes 2/3XL and 4/5XL only:

1st row: (RS). Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1.

2nd row: P1. P2tog. Purl to end of row.

3rd row: As 1st row.

4th row: Purl.

Rep last 4 rows (2-9) times more, then 1st and 2nd rows once. 39 sts.

All sizes: Shape neck:

1st row: (RS). Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1.

2nd row: Purl to last **8** (9-10-11-10-10) sts. **Turn.** Leave rem sts on a st holder. **23** (23-23-23-28-28) sts.

3rd row: ssk. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1.

4th row: P2tog. Purl to last 3 sts. P2togtbl. P1.

5th row: As 3rd row.

6th row: Purl to last 2 sts. P2togtbl.

7th row: As 3rd row.

Sizes XS/S, M, L and XL only:

8th row: P1. P2tog. Purl to end of row.

9th row: As 3rd row

10th row: Purl.

11th row: As 3rd row.

12th row: As 8th row.

13th row: Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1.

14th row: Purl.

15th row: As 13th row.

Rep last 4 rows once more. 3 sts.

Next row: (WS). P2tog. P1. 2 sts.

Next row: K2tog. Fasten off.

Sizes 2/3XL and 4/5XL only:

8th row: As 4th row.

9th row: As 3rd row.

10th row: Purl.

11th row: As 3rd row.

12th row: P1. P2tog. Purl to end of row.

13th row: As 3rd row.

14th row: Purl.

15th row: Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1.

16th row: As 12th row.

17th row: As 15th row.

Rep 14th to 17th rows once more. 4 sts.

Next row: (WS). P4.

Next row: K2. K2tog.

Next row: P2tog. P1.

Next row: K2tog. Fasten off.

SLEEVES

With smaller needles, cast on **40** (**40-45-45-49-49**) sts.

Knit 7 rows (garter st), noting first row is WS and inc 3 sts evenly across last row. **43** (**43-48-48-52-52**) sts.

Change to larger needles and proceed in stocking st, inc 1 st each end of needle on 5th and every following **6th** (**6th-6th-4th-4th-2nd**) row to **49** (**51-52-66-94-70**) sts, then every following **8th** (**6th-6th-6th-6th-4th**) row to **67** (**71-76-86-96-104**) sts.

Cont even until work from beg measures **17½** (**18-18-17½-17-16½**)" [**44.5** (**45.5-45.5-44.5-43-42**) cm], ending with a WS row.

Shape raglans: Cast off **5** (**5-5-7-8-8**) sts beg next 2 rows. **57** (**61-66-72-80-88**) sts. Work 2 rows even.

Next row: (RS). K1. ssk. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1.

Work 3 rows even.

Rep last 4 rows **1** (**1-1-0-0-0**) time more. **53** (**57-62-70-78-86**) sts.

Next row: (RS). K1. ssk. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1.

Next row: Purl.

Rep last 2 rows **21** (**23-25-27-28-30**) times more. **9** (**9-10-14-20-24**) sts.

Sizes XL, 2/3XL and 4/5XL only:

Next row: (RS). K1. ssk. Knit to last 3 sts. K2tog. K1.

Next row: P1. P2tog. Purl to last 3 sts. P2togtbl. P1.

Rep last 2 rows (**0-1-2**) time(s) more. (**10-12-12**) sts.

All sizes: Leave rem **9** (**9-10-10-12-12**) sts on a st holder.

FINISHING

Neckband: Sew raglan seams. With RS of work facing and smaller needles, K**8** (**9-10-11-10-10**) from right front st holder. Pick up and knit **14** (**14-14-14-17-17**) sts up right front neck edge. K**9** (**9-10-10-12-12**) from right sleeve st holder. K**34** (**36-38-40-42-42**) from back neck st holder, dec 2 sts evenly across. K**9** (**9-10-10-12-12**) from left sleeve st holder. Pick up and knit **14** (**14-14-14-17-17**) sts down left front neck edge. K**8** (**9-10-11-10-10**) from left front st holder. **94** (**98-104-108-118**) sts. Knit 4 rows. Cast off knitwise (WS).

Front opening edging:

With RS of work facing and smaller needles, pick up and knit **26** (**29-31-32-32-35**) sts down left front opening edge. Pick up and knit **26** (**29-31-32-32-35**) sts up right front opening edge. Cast off.

Sew side and sleeve seams.
