What you will need:

RED HEART® Super Saver®:
1 skein 312 Black

Susan Bates® Crochet Hook:
8mm [US L-11]

Yarn needle, 24" (61 cm) 20 gauge
black wire, ½ yard (.5 mm) ¼"
or ½" wide black elastic, sewing
needle and black thread

GAUGE: 10 sts = 4" (10 cm); 7
rows = 4" (10 cm). **CHECK YOUR
GAUGE.** Use any size hook to
obtain the gauge.

Mask Gone Batty

*Go batty this season with the perfect
mask. Crochet quickly for a Halloween look
in a hurry!*

Mask measures 16½" wide x 4½" long
(42 x 11.5 cm)

Special Stitch

Picot = Ch 3, slip st in 3rd ch from hook.

Notes

1. Mask is worked from top down in rows.
Last round creates a picot edging.
2. Wire is inserted through upper edge so
wings will flair out.

MASK

Beginning at the top, ch 40.

Row 1 (right side): Dc in 3rd ch from hook
(beginning ch counts as first dc), 2 dc in next
2 ch, dc in next 7 ch, hdc in next 4 ch, sc in
next 10 ch, hdc in next 4 ch, dc in next 7 ch, 2
dc in last 3 ch, turn—44 sts.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and
throughout), dc in first st, 2 dc in next st, dc in
next 11 sts, hdc in next 4 sts, sc in next 10 sts,
hdc in next 4 sts, dc in next 11 sts, 2 dc in next
st, 2 dc in top of beginning ch, turn—48 sts.

Row 3: Ch 3, dc in first st, 2 dc in next dc, dc
in next 15 sts, ch 10, skip next 5 sts, hdc in
next 4 sts, ch 10, skip next 5 sts, dc in next 15
sts, 2 dc in next dc, 2 dc in top of beginning
ch, turn—42 sts and 2 ch-10 spaces.

Row 4: Ch 3, dc in first st, 2 dc in next st, dc
in next 17 sts, 10 hdc in first 10-ch space, hdc
in next 4 sts, 10 hdc in next 10-ch space, dc
in next 17 sts, 2 dc in next st, 2 dc in top of
beginning ch, turn—66 sts.

Row 5: Ch 3, dc in first st, 2 dc in next st, dc
in next 19 sts, hdc in next 24 sts, dc in next 19
sts, 2 dc in next st, 2 dc in top of beginning ch,
turn—70 sts.

Round 6: Ch 3, dc in first st, (2 dc, picot, dc)
in next st, hdc in next st, sc in next st, *slip st
in next st, sc in next st, hdc in next st, (2 dc,
picot, dc) in next st, hdc in next st, sc in next
st; repeat from * once, sc in next 17 sts, hdc
in next st, dc in next st, (2 dc, picot, dc) in next
st, hdc in next st, sc in next 17 sts, **sc in
next st, hdc in next st, (2 dc, picot, dc) in next
st, hdc in next st, sc in next st, slip st in next
st; repeat from ** once, sc in next st, hdc in
next st, (2 dc, picot, dc) in next st, 2 dc in top
of beginning ch, sc in end of each row, sc in
next 16 sts, hdc in next st, (2 dc, picot, dc) in
next st, hdc in next st, sc in next 6 sts, hdc in
next st, (2 dc, picot, dc) in next st, hdc in next
st, sc in remaining sts across, sc in end of
each row; join with slip st in top of beginning
ch. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Insert wire through wrong side of mask and
bend to spread out the wings.

With sewing needle and thread, sew elastic
band to wrong side at outer edges of eye
holes, adjusting to fit as needed.

ch = chain; dc = double crochet; hdc = half
double crochet; sc = single crochet; st(s) =
stitch(es); () = work directions in parentheses
into same st; * = repeat whatever follows the
* as indicated.
