Y-A-R-N Wrapped Letters

Here are specific instructions on how our Y-A-R-N letters were wrapped. We've included a photo with yarn key letters to identify the yarns. You can, of course, wrap other letters however you would like with the same or different yarns.

What you will need:

FOR PINK "Y"

SHOP KIT



Note

These letters are made to stand on a flat surface, so there is no need to cover the bottom edges of the letters with yarn. If you are making the letters to hang, glue a small pieces of yarn to the bottom of the letters until no cardboard is showing. Cover each section of the letter with a thin coat of glue before wrapping to secure yarn in place. Let glue dry between steps.

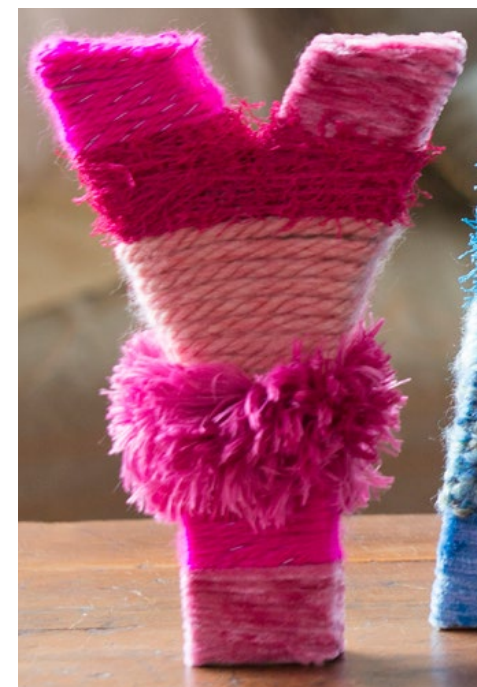
Refer to yarn list and key to identify the yarns used and placement.

How to Wrap the Letter Y

1. Spread a small amount of glue around the bottom section of the 'Y'. Secure the end of **A** to the bottom and let dry.
2. Wrap **A** around the letter approximately 10 times. Cut the yarn and secure with glue.
3. Spread glue around the next section of the letter above **A**. Secure the end of **B** directly above **A** and let dry.
4. Wrap **B** around the letter approximately 10 times. Cut the yarn and secure with glue.

5. Spread glue around the next section above **B**. Secure the end of **C** directly above **B** and let dry.
6. Wrap **C** around the letter approximately 4 times. Cut the yarn and secure with glue.
7. Repeat with **D** and **E**. Wrap **D** around approximately 10 times. Wrap **E** around approximately 40 times or enough to cover the cardboard. Work **E** up and around each side at the separation of the letter. Cut the yarn and secure with glue.
8. On the left side of the separation, glue **B** directly above **E** and wrap until you reach the top of the letter. Cut the yarn and secure the end along the top of the letter.
9. Cut a small piece of **B**, lightly cover the top of the left side with glue, and cover with **B**.
10. Repeat steps 8 and 9 on the right side of the letter with **A**. Let dry.

How to Wrap the Letter A

1. Spread a small amount of glue around the bottom section of the left leg of the letter. Secure the end of **F** and let dry.
2. Wrap **F** approximately 10-15 times around the left leg of the letter. Cut the yarn and secure with glue.
3. On the right leg of the letter, spread a small amount of glue along the bottom. Secure **G** and let dry.
4. Wrap **G** approximately 50 times around the right leg of the letter until you reach the bridge. Cut the yarn and secure with glue.
5. Spread glue around the remaining section of the left leg of the letter directly above **F**. Secure the end of **H** and let dry.
6. Wrap **H** around the left leg about 4 times to the bridge of the letter.
7. Spread glue around the lower half of the bridge and continue to wrap **H** around the entire letter about 4 more times until half of the bridge is covered. Cut the yarn and secure with glue.
8. Glue the end of **I** directly on top of **H** and let dry.
9. Wrap **I** about 8 times around the entire bridge about 4 times.
10. Continue to wrap **I** around the right side of the letter, threading the yarn through the hole about 4 more times. Cut the yarn and secure with glue.
11. Glue and secure the end of **J** on the left side of the letter above **I**.

12. Spread glue around the left side of the letter and around the entire letter above the hole. Wrap **J** around the left side of the letter, threading through the hole, until the top of the hole. Then continue to wrap around the entire letter until yarn has been wrapped around letter approximately 60 times in total. Cut the yarn and secure with glue.
13. Glue and secure the end of **G** directly above **J** and let dry.
14. Wrap **G** around approximately 15 times and secure the other end with glue.
15. Glue the end of **F** above **G** and let dry.
16. Wrap **F** about 7 times or until you reach the top of the letter and secure the other end with glue.
17. Cut a small piece of **F**, cover the top of the letter with glue, and lay **F** on top of the letter. Cover the entire top section of the letter. Let dry.



How to Wrap the Letter R

1. Begin along the bottom edge of the top loop of the letter. Glue and secure the end of **K** adjacent to the long straight leg of the letter.
2. Wrap **K** around, moving to the right, approximately 30 times, working your way up around the outside of the loop. Cut the yarn and secure with glue.
3. There will most likely be cardboard still showing in the middle of this section, so cut short pieces of **K** and glue them to fill in the empty spaces.
4. Glue and secure the end of **L** directly below **K** so it will wrap around the right leg of the letter.
5. Wrap **L** around until you reach the bottom of the leg and secure the end with glue.
6. Glue and secure **M** along the top right edge of the loop adjacent to the **K** and let dry.
7. Wrap **M** around approximately 40 times until you are close to the top left corner of the letter. Cut the yarn and secure with glue.
8. Glue and secure another piece of **L** next to **M** in the top left corner.
9. Wrap **L** around about 15 times around the corner until about halfway down the left side of the letter, glue and secure the other end of **L** and let dry.
10. Cut 4-5 short pieces of **N** and glue them back to front, filling the space below **L** and next to **K** until you reach the left leg of the letter. Cut the yarn and secure with glue.
11. Secure and glue the end of **O** directly underneath **N**.
12. Wrap **O** around the right leg of the letter until you reach the bottom. Cut the yarn and secure with glue. Let dry.



How to Wrap the Letter N

1. Glue and secure **P** along the top left corner of the letter.
2. Moving downwards, wrap **P** approximately 15 times until you reach the corner connecting the top left and the top right sections of the letter. Cut the yarn and glue the end.
3. Cut a smaller piece of **P**, spread glue on the top of the left side of the letter and cover with **P**.
4. Glue and secure end of **Q** under **P**.
5. Wrap **Q** downwards about 5 times around the left leg of the letter under the **P**. Cut the yarn and glue the end.
6. Then working up the middle section and right leg of the letter, glue and wrap **Q** around letter until you reach the top. Glue the end along the top and let dry.

7. Cut a smaller piece of **Q** and glue and cover the top of the leg.
8. Cut a section of **G** where the yarn is green. Glue and secure the end directly under **Q** on the left leg.
9. Wrap **G** around until you reach the very bottom of the letter, and secure the end with glue.
10. Glue another piece of **P** under **Q** on the right leg of the letter.
11. Working downwards, wrap **P** approximately 10 times, leaving about 1 inch for the last color. Secure the end with glue and let dry.
12. Glue the end of **R** below **P** and let dry.
13. Wrap **R** around the bottom right section of the letter about 3 times, or until you reach the bottom of the letter. Secure the end with glue and let dry.
