



CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: **EASY**

## ABBREVIATIONS

**Approx** = Approximately  
**Beg** = Beginning  
**Ch** = Chain(s)  
**Rem** = Remain(s)(ing)  
**Rep** = Repeat  
**Rnd** = Round  
**RS** = Right side  
**Sc** = Single crochet  
**Sl st** = Slip stitch  
**St(s)** = Stitch(es)  
**Tog** = Together

**Tss** = One row of Tunisian simple stitch is worked in two steps as follows: 1) Forward Pass (right to left): Skip first vertical thread. \*Insert hook into front loop only of next vertical thread. Yoh and draw up a st. Rep from \* to last vertical thread. Insert hook into both front and back loops of last vertical thread. Yoh and draw up a st.

2) Return Pass (left to right): Yoh and draw through first st on hook. \*Yoh and draw through 2 sts on hook. Rep from \* until only one st remains on hook.



One row of Tss complete.  
**WS** = Wrong side  
**Yoh** = Yarn over hook



## MATERIALS

**Caron® Cakes™** (8.5 oz/240 g; 445 yds/407 m)

**Contrast A** Blue Raspberry (49007) **4 cakes**

**Contrast B** Orange Marmalade (49003) **3 cakes**

Size U.S. 10½ (6.5 mm) flexible cable Tunisian crochet hook.  
 Size U.S. H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**  
 Yarn needle.

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 50" x 60" [127 x 152.5 cm].

## GAUGE

13 sts and 13 rows = 4" [10 cm] in Tss.

**Note:** 1 row of Tunisian Crochet Pat = Forward and Return Pass.

## INSTRUCTIONS


### Notes:

- To maintain consistent color changes, join new ball of yarn to match last color change of previous ball. This will help to ensure stripe repeat will match as closely as possible.
- Work all rows with RS of work facing.
- **Do not** break yarn when changing colors. Leave color not in use at side of work to be picked up for subsequent rows.
- Skip first st of each Forward pass, drawing up first stitch in second horizontal bar.
- Last stitch of each Forward pass should be worked into both front and back loop of stitch to create a neat edge.


**BLANKET** (Blanket is worked lengthwise).

With Tunisian hook and A, ch 184 **loosely**.

**1st row: Forward pass:** (*Right* to left). With A, and working into bumps at back of foundation chain, draw up a loop in 2nd ch from hook. Draw up a loop in each rem ch to end of chain, leaving all loops on hook. 184 sts on hook. **Do not turn.**



**Return pass:** (*Left* to right after working Forward pass of each row). With B, yoh and draw through last loop **only** (for edge st). \*Yoh and draw through 2 loops. Rep from \* until 1 loop rem on hook. **Do not turn.**



**2nd row: Forward pass:** (*Right* to left). With B, \*1Tss in next st. Rep from \* to end of row. With A, return pass.

**3rd row: Forward pass:** (*Right* to left). With A, \*1Tss in next st. Rep from \* to end of row. With B, return pass.

Rep last 2nd and 3rd rows until work from beg measures approx 56" [142 cm], ending with a return pass in A.

**Finishing Row:** With A, \*Insert hook into front loop only of next vertical thread. Yoh and draw up a st, drawing through loop on hook (only one loop rem on hook). Rep from \* to end of row. Fasten off.

**Border:** With RS facing and U.S. H/8 (5 mm) crochet hook, join A with sl st to any corner of Blanket.

**1st rnd:** Ch 1. Work sc evenly around entire edge of Blanket working (1 sc. Ch 1. 1 sc) in each corner. Join with sl st to first sc.

**2nd rnd:** Ch 1. 1 sc in each sc around working (1 sc. Ch 1. 1 sc) in each corner ch-1 sp. Join with sl st to first sc.

Rep last rnd 5 times more. Fasten off.
