Paper - Pieced Block Series

The technique used in these blocks is foundation paper piecing. You need to be familiar with this technique to make this quilt.

We recommend Coats Dual Duty XP® Paper Piecing thread when sewing the foundation blocks. This thread is fine, but strong. This means you can sew perfect points without adding bulk and the stitches will not distort or break when the paper is torn away.

Threads

Coats Dual Duty XP® Paper Piecing thread- neutral color
Coats® Cotton Machine Quilting - thread - color 813 Over the Rainbow or color of your choice

Notes

WOF=width of fabric

Fat eighth = 9" x 22" (22.86x 55.88cm)

Fat quarter = 18" x 22" (45.72x 55.88cm)

The fabric needed to make the entire wall hanging is listed below.

The fabrics required for each step will be repeated at the beginning of the block instructions.


Additional Requirements

Copies of foundations (4 each of blocks 1 through 5)

50" x 50" (127x 127cm) piece of low-loft batting

Backing Fabric

3 yds(2.75m) Royal Blue Marbled CBFS005.ROYAL



Printing the Foundations

- For each block, you'll need to print four copies of the foundation on your home printer or at a copy shop. The foundations will be supplied as full-size PDF files. You'll need Adobe Reader, a free download, to view and print the files.
- In the printer dialog box, be sure the options Fit to Page and Resize are NOT checked, Actual Size or print at 100% should be selected (See example) or that the No Scaling option is checked. Print one copy of the foundation to test your printer's accuracy and measure the test square printed on the page; it should measure 1" on each side. If not, review and change your printer settings as necessary before printing the remaining foundations.
- Each section of Blocks 2-5 will fit on a single piece of letter-size paper (8½" x 11"). Print Block 1 on two pieces of letter-size paper and join the sections as indicated, securing them with regular office tape, before piecing.
- Print each foundation on a sheet of lightweight copy paper, the same paper you ordinarily use for printing. Specialty papers for foundation piecing are fine but not necessary.
