

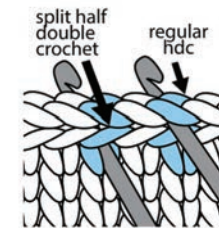


CROCHET | SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

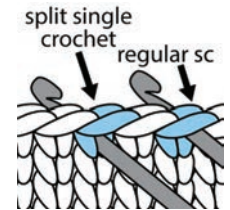
ABBREVIATIONS

- Approx** = Approximately
- Ch** = Chain(s)
- Cont** = Continue(ity)
- Hdcbl** = Half double crochet in back loop only
- Rep** = Repeat
- Rnd(s)** = Round(s)
- RS** = Right side
- Sc** = Single crochet
- Sl st** = Slip stitch

Splhdc = Split half double crochet: work hdc between 'legs' at front and back of stitch (splitting stitch) instead of through top loops. Stitches should appear as "V"s on RS and WS of work.



Splsc = Split single crochet: work sc between 'legs' of stitch (splitting stitch) instead of through top loops

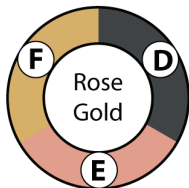
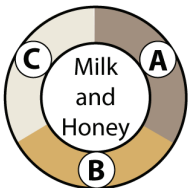


- Sp(s)** = Space(s)
- St(s)** = Stitch(es)
- WS** = Wrong side

MATERIALS

Bernat® Blanket™ O'Go™ (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)

- Milk and Honey (42005) **1 O'Go**
- Rose Gold (42019) **1 O'Go**



Size U.S. N/15 (10 mm) crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Stitch marker. Yarn needle.

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 13" [33 cm] diameter x 10½" [26.5 cm] tall.

GAUGES

7 splsc and 8.5 rounds = 4" [10 cm].
7 splhdc and 7 rounds = 4" [10 cm]

INSTRUCTIONS

BASKET

Notes:

- To begin working with the O'Go format, carefully cut plastic tie where the ends of the O'Go meet.
- Pull tie to remove.
- Colors can be easily separated by gently pulling apart and cutting at the color transition. Each color is ready to use.
- Designate each color A, B, C, D, E, F as indicated in Materials.

Base Note: Do not join at ends of rnds unless otherwise stated. Cont working in spiral placing marker on first st of each subsequent rnd for easier counting.

Wth B, ch 2.

1st rnd: 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook. 6 sc.

Cont working in spiral as follows:

2nd rnd: 2 splsc in each sc around. 12 sts.

3rd rnd: *2 splsc in next st. 1 splsc in next st. Rep from * around. 18sts.

4th rnd: *1 splsc in next st. 2 splsc in next st. 1 splsc in next st. Rep from * around. 24 sts.

5th rnd: *2 splsc in next st. 1 splsc in each of next 3 sts. Rep from * around. 30 sts.

6th rnd: *1 splsc in each of next 2 sts. 2 splsc in next st. 1 splsc in each of next 2 sts. Rep from * around. 36 sts.

7th rnd: *2 splsc in next st. 1 splsc in each of next 5 sts. Rep from * around. 42 sts.

8th rnd: *1 splsc in each of next 3 sts. 2 splsc in next st. 1 splsc in each of next 3 sts. Rep from * around. 48 sts.

9th rnd: *2 splsc in next st. 1 splsc in each of next 7 sts. Rep from * around. 54 sts.

10th rnd: *1 splsc in each of next 4 sts. 2 splsc in next st. 1 splsc in each of next 4 sts. Rep from * around. 60 sts.

11th rnd: *2 splsc in next st. 1 splsc in each of next 9 sts. Rep from * around. 66 sts.

12th rnd: 1 splsc in each st around.

13th rnd: *1 splsc in each of next 5 sts. 2 splsc in next st. 1 splsc in each of next 5 sts. Rep from * around. 72 sts.

14th rnd: 1 splsc in each st around. With F, join with sl st to first st. Break B.

Do not fasten off.

Cont with Sides as follows:

Side Note: Rnds are joined with sl st to first st.

1st rnd: With F, ch 1. 1 hdcbl in each st around. Join. 72 sts.

2nd to 4th rnds: Ch 1. 1 splhdc in each st around. Join. 72 sts.

5th rnd: Ch 1. 1 splhdc in each st around. Join with A. Fasten off.

Proceed with Intarsia Pat as follows:

Notes:

- Turn after each rnd, working odd rnds with RS facing and even rnds with WS facing.
- Use separate balls of yarn for each area of color in the design (as shown in Diagram on page 3). When joining colors, work to last 2 loops on hook of first color. Pick up new color from under old color at WS of work to lock colors in to avoid a hole. Draw new color through last 2 loops and proceed in new color, leaving old color at WS of work.
- Chart is shown on page 3.

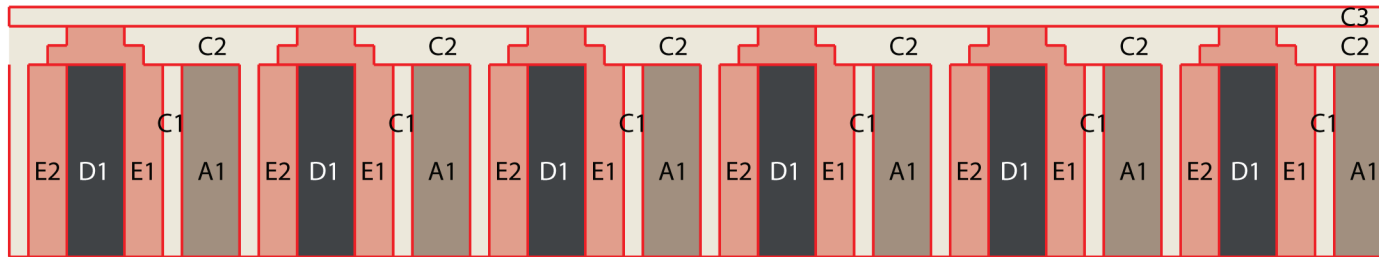
Beg working Chart in splhdc, reading RS rnds from **right to left** and WS rnds from **left to right**, noting 12-st rep will be worked 6 times, until 13th rnd of Chart is complete as follows:

1st rnd: (RS). With appropriate color, ch 1 (**does not** count as st). Working from Chart using appropriate color, rep 12-st rep 6 times total, 1 splhdc in each st around. Join. Turn. 72 sts.

2nd rnd: (WS). With appropriate color, ch 1 (**does not** count as st). 1 splhdc in same first st. Working from Chart using appropriate color, rep 12-st rep 6 times total, 1 splhdc in each st around. Join. Turn.

Keeping cont of chart, rep last 2 rnds until 13th rnd of Chart is complete, ending on a RS rnd. Fasten off.

INTARSIA DIAGRAM



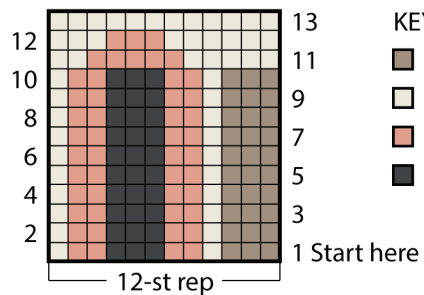
*Diagram shows full Intarsia pattern (6 Repeats of 12-st rep). Red lines indicated where each separate ball of wound color will be used

Section	Total Wound Balls Required	Approx Length of Each Ball Required
A1 = Color A	6	7 yds/7 m
C1 = Color C	6	3 yds/3 m
C2 = Color C	6	6 yds/6 m
C3 = Color C	1	16 yds/15 m
D1 = Color D	6	7 yds/7 m
E1 = Color E	6	6 yds/6 m
E2 = Color E	6	5 yds/5 m

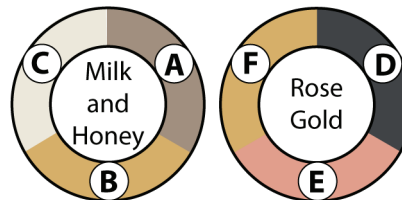
SEPARATE BALLS REQUIRED FOR EACH AREA OF COLOR IN INTARSIA PAT

NOTES:

- Each square represents 1 splhdc.
- 12-st rep will be repeated 6 times total around Basket.
- Turn after each rnd, reading RS rnds from right to left (odd rnds) and WS rnds from left to right (even rnds).
