Amigurumi Angel Ornaments

This sweet Angel is quick to crochet and can be used at Christmas or anytime you need a little heavenly spirit. Perfect as an ornament or as a package tie-on, you'll love how this Angel reflects your love of crochet!

Ornament measures 5" (12.5 cm) tall.

Note

All pieces are worked in unjoined rounds with right side facing at all times. Place marker for beginning of round and move marker up as each round is completed. Do not join until instructed.

Special Stitch

sc2tog = [Insert hook in next stitch, yarn over and pull up a loop] twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook.

ORNAMENT (make 1 each with B and C for body and arms) Head

Beginning at top, with **A**, ch 2.

Round 1: Work 6 sc in 2nd ch from hook—6 sc. Place marker for beginning of round and move marker up as each round is completed.

Round 2: Work 2 sc in each sc around—12 sc.

Round 3: *Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * around—18 sc.

Round 4: *Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * around—24 sc.

Round 5: Sc in each sc around.

Round 6: *Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * around—30 sc.

Rounds 7-11: Repeat Round 5.

Round 12: *Sc2tog; repeat from * around—15 sc.

Round 13: Repeat Round 5; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

With blue embroidery floss, embroider **French knot** eyes on Round 10. Lightly color cheeks with red crayon.

Body

Beginning at bottom, ch 2.

Rounds 1 and 2: Work same as Rounds 1 and 2 of head—12 sc.

Round 3: *Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc; repeat from * around—15 sc.

Rounds 4-8: Work same as Round 5 of head.

Round 9: *Sc in next 3 sc, sc2tog; repeat from * around—12 sc.

Round 10: Work same as Round 5 of head. Stuff body with fiberfill.

Round 11: Work same as Round 12 of head; join with slip st in first sc—6 sc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Weave tail through last round and pull closed.

Arm (make 2)

Ch 2.

Round 1: Work same as Round 1 of head—6 sc.

Round 2: Repeat Round 3 of head—9 sc.

Rounds 3-6: Repeat Round 5 of head; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Do not stuff.

Wing (make 2)

With **D**, ch 6.

Round 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in next 3 ch, 3 sc in last ch; working in opposite side of foundation ch, skip first ch, sc in next 3 chs, 2 sc in last ch—12 sc. Place marker for beginning of round and move marker up as each round is completed.

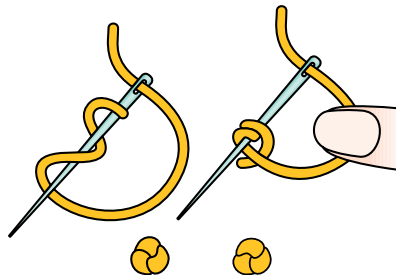
Round 2: 2 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next 3 sc, sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next 2 sc—18 sc.

continued...



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Round 3: Sc in next 3 sc, slip st in next sc, [ch 1, 3 dc in next sc, ch 1, slip st in next sc] 5 times, sc in next 4 sc; join with slip st in first sc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

Halo

With **D**, ch 4.

Round 1: Work 11 dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as first dc); join with slip st in top of beginning ch—12 dc.

Round 2: Ch 3 (counts as first dc here and throughout), dc in same st as join, 2 dc in each remaining dc around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—24 dc.

Round 3: Ch 3, 2 dc in next dc, *dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc; repeat from * around; join with slip st in top of beginning ch—36 dc. Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

Assembly

Arms Weave tail through last round and pull stitches closed, then sew in place at top of body.

Head & Body Stuff head with fiberfill.

Push Round 13 of head onto top of body. With end tail, sew securely around to join head to body. Sew waistband around body.

Wings With right side facing front, sew to back of body.

Halo With right side facing front, sew to back of head.

FINISHING

Cut strand of white embroidery floss to desired length for hanging loop, thread through top of ornament and tie ends into a knot.

Weave in ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

A, B, C = Color A, Color B, Color C, etc.; **ch** = chain(s); **dc** = double crochet; **sc** = single crochet; **st(s)** = stitch(es); * = repeat whatever follows the * as indicated.
